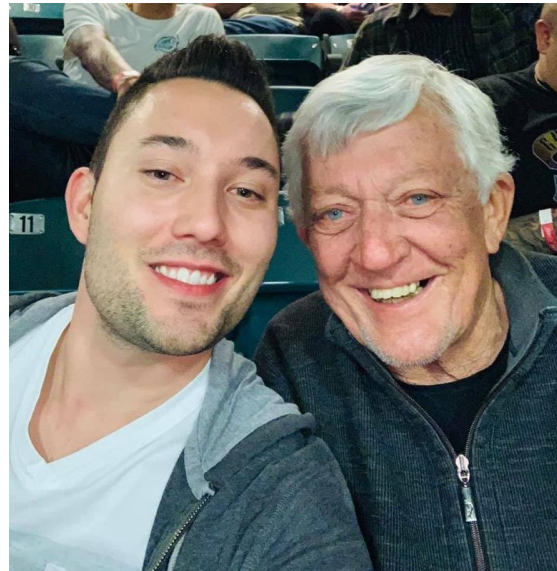

Export broodmare deadline is fast approaching

**THE NMHBA MUST HAVE YOUR PAID EXPORT
BROODMARE APPLICATIONS NO LATER THAN
TUESDAY, OCTOBER 1, 2019.**

The NMHBA Trustees voted to amend the timeframe that an owner has to provide the Association with the forms for Broodmares in Foal to Leave the State of New Mexico. Beginning with the 2019 breeding season the form and the fee will be due on October 1 of the year bred. The form must be postmarked or received in our office by that date

**You are now Leaving
New Mexico**

(October 1) or the \$2000 fee will be assessed to make the resulting foal eligible to be a NM bred.

Failure to return the mare to foal in New Mexico will result in the foal NOT being registered as a New Mexico bred and that foal will NOT be eligible for the New Mexico bred program. The Broodmare in foal returning to New Mexico form must also be submitted to the office BEFORE foaling. **NO refund of fees will be made.**

These changes were made to allow the owners of the mares going out of state during their pregnancy, to have their mares confirmed in foal before the member pays the fees. Your mare must still be registered with the association by September 1st of the

breeding year.

If you are taking your mare out of New Mexico to patriciate in a recognized sale, the Board of Trustees is giving special consideration to purchasers of pregnant New Mexico registered broodmares to participate in our Export Broodmare Program. As long as we have a form on file from the original owner for the mare to leave to said sale, if the purchaser wishes to board the mare out of state, they will have 10 days from the purchase date to fill out the export broodmare form and pay the \$500 fee.

ATTENTION STALLION OWNERS AND FARMS STANDING STALLIONS



The NMHBA has changed a few things this year regarding the stallion update cards and the EVA forms. Rather than sending these out separately as we have done in prior years, we will be sending out one mailing this coming Tuesday October 1st, 2019. The mailing will include a letter explaining the simple change, a form to gather stallion information (taking the place of the stallion update cards) and a 2020 EVA booster form.

The Stallion update form must be filled out by the owner or farm standing and returned to the NMHBA office no later than Thursday, October 31st, 2019 for your stallion to remain in an active status and to be included in our stallion magazine. The 2020 EVA booster form must be filled out by your vet and returned to the NMHBA office by Tuesday, January 14th, 2020.

If your stallion goes inactive for either of the above reasons, there is a \$200.00 reactivation fee to be paid accompanied by the stallion reactivation form.

PLEASE NOTE: A NM Bred Colt or Filly does not automatically go into the Broodmare and Stallion Registries. Please refer to the website or call the office for questions on this.

New Mexico State Fair at Albuquerque (17 days) — August 30-September 20

Zia Park (54 days) — September 21-December 22.
