No exceptions will be made If your mare foals anywhere other than New Mexico. Don't forget when you bring your pregnant mare back to the state you must submit the return form to the breeders office prior to foaling. EVA Boosters are due by

January 14, 2020

Failure to return an EVA booster certification signed by a licensed NM vet to the NMHBA will result in your stallion being marked <u>inactive</u>. Once a stallion is marked inactive, you will be charged a \$200 reactivation fee, must meet EVA requirements, and may face additional penalties on any foals bred while the sire was in an inactive status.

Starting with Quarter Horse foals born in 2019, the breeder of record will be whoever owned the mare at the time of **conception**. QH foals born prior to 2019 the breeder of record will still be owner of the mare at time of foaling.

Thoroughbreds remain the same, owner at time of foaling.
