2020 Sales information

There will be 4 sales going on in 2020 for NM Bred Horses

The 2020 Ruidoso Select Yearling Sale, the 2020 New Mexico Bred Sale and the Foal In Utero Sale will be conducted at the Lazy E Arena in Guthrie, Oklahoma, on August 27, 28 and 29.

After weighing several factors relating to the annual horse sales, specifically the current New Mexico Public Health Order which limits mass gatherings, All-American Ruidoso Horse Sale will partner with Lazy E Arena, located just north of Oklahoma City, to hold the sales.

The two long-standing sales will also be combined into a single event.

With a start time of 10 a.m. each day, the Thursday session will feature approximately 200 New Mexico-bred yearlings. The Friday/Saturday sessions will offer approximately 400 Select Quarter Horse Yearlings, 20 Select Foals In Utero, and the partial R.D. Hubbard dispersal.

The live sale event will be streamed online at RaceRuidoso.com at no charge. Interested buyers will be able to bid onsite and via phone only. Horses will arrive on site at the Lazy E and will be available for inspection beginning August 25. A single catalog will be produced for all three days and will be available the first week of August. A catalog can be requested at RaceRuidoso.com.

The sale dates are the weekend after the All American Futurity and Derby trials, which occur at Ruidoso Downs August 21 through 23.

“We will not have the magic of Ruidoso this year, but the Lazy E arena is a nice air-conditioned facility that is used to hosting big events and will accommodate our specific needs. We look forward to returning to Ruidoso in 2021,” said Lowell Neumayer, General Manager of the All-American Horse Sale Co. “The All-American Ruidoso Horse Sale Co. is very grateful to Gary and Micah McKinney and Dan Wall of the Lazy E, and the Ruidoso Downs owners and management for their assistance in helping to arrive at this solution.”

Photos

Four Conformation Photos are REQUIRED for each entry. Both sides in profile front and rear. To maximize your return, it is crucial to provide quality pictures of entry. Up to 6 photos can be uploaded and displayed for each entry.

• **Think about what shoppers look at when you show your horses at a live sale. That's what you want to show them.**

Videos

We require a conformation / walking video for each entry. Video the horse walking to and from you and walking side to side, both directions. Up to 3 additional videos can be displayed.

Vet Exam

We provide a form for a basic physical exam try. This is REQUIRED for each entry

Radiographs

Normally optional in our auctions. We welcome input as to whether x-rays should be required.

ThoroughbredAuctions.Com announces the complete dispersal of Thoroughbreds owned by the late R.D. Hubbard. The auction will be an internet only auction, with bidding opening on

Tuesday, July 21st and closing on Tuesday July 28th. The online catalog is available at ThroughbredAuctions.com.

R.D.Hubbard was an icon in the horse racing industry. He raced both Thoroughbreds and Quarter Horses. Some of his more prominent Thoroughbreds include such luminaries as Corwyn Bay (IRE), Gentlemen (ARG), Stravinsky and many more. Hubbard bought Ruidoso Downs in 1988 with partner Dr. Ed Allred, and eventually became the sole owner until he sold it in 2017. He helped create the National Thoroughbred Racing Association, and as a member of NTRA's board of directors, he co-founded its Racing Integrity and Drug Testing Task Force.

He also built and operated The Woodlands, a dual greyhound and racehorse facility in Kansas City, Kansas. In addition, Hubbard has been chairman of Hollywood Park and Turf Paradise, and he headed a group that was awarded the license to build Zia Park in 2003.

The auction features **Attila's Storm**, Multiple Stakes Winner of \$534,983, national and regional leading sire with 74% of his starters winning and \$56,282 Average Earning, \$13.3 Million Lifetime Progeny Earnings and Champion NM TB Sire 2016-2019.

The auction will also feature NM bred Yearlings, Weanlings, Horses of Racing Age and Broodmares.

Included are Stakes Winner **Another Brother**, g.6 \$239,00 (by Attila's Storm), Multiple Stakes Winner **FLIGHT SONG**, m.4 \$182,000 (by Attila's Storm), Stakes Winner **Two Stepper** \$120,000 f. 3 (by Attila's Storm), Stakes Winner **Let It Roll** \$194,000 m.4 (by Roll Hennessy Roll), Stakes Placed **Evacuee** \$153,000 g.3 (by Abstraction)

Also included are Black Type Producing mares by sires such as Hennessy, Bernardini, Danzig, Giant's Causeway, Pulpit, Grand Slam, Mr Greeley, and Posse.
