1st!

If a registered NM Broodmare in foal to a registered NM Stallion leaves the state of New Mexico

- this application and \$500 fee must be postmarked **no later than October 1st.**
- if the mare leaves after October 1st, this application and \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than ten (10) days from the date of departure.
- if the application and \$500 fee are NOT received by the applicable deadline, the fee increases to \$2,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.
- No fees are required, if the mare is consigned to an advertised sale out of the State of NM if this form is completed and returned to the NMHBA. The mare may then

leave NM seven (7) days prior to the sale and must return to NM no later than seven (7) days after the completion of the sale for the foal she is carrying to maintain eligibility for NM Bred accreditation. If the Broodmare is not returned to NM, a grace period of ten (10) days will be granted for the \$500 fee to be paid for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.

MJ Farms' Donelli will put her undefeated record at Albuquerque Downs on the line in Sunday's 400-yard, \$252,077 New Mexico State Fair Quarter Horse Derby (R). Donelli has won all three of her starts at The Downs, including last year's New Mexico State Fair Quarter Horse Futurity (RG3).

Zia Park opens its shortened 36-day season on October 5. The New Mexico Cup stakes will be spread out over two days, November 9 for Quarter Horses and November 11 for Thoroughbreds. At this time, spectators will not be allowed to attend the races. Click on the [link](#) for more information.

Albuquerque Downs ends its 2020 season with an 11-race program on Sunday, starting at 1:30 p.m. (MDT), and New Mexico-breds will be well-represented in the track's signature Quarter Horse race, the \$300,000 Albuquerque Fall Championship (G1). NM-breds Jess A Satin Flash, No Mires A La Luna, Marcus Medallion, and Diamond And A Half are among the 12 entered in the 440-yard dash, though Diamond And A Half is on the also-eligible list and will need a scratch to draw in.



Thunder Dome got back on the winning track in Sunday's 7-furlong, \$100,000 O.D. McDonald Stakes (R) at Albuquerque Downs. Shane Laviolette rode the 6-year-old Dome gelding for owners W.D. Carson Sr., M.H. Carson, and Leach Racing, and trainer Dallas Barton. A five-time stakes winner, Thunder Dome was winning for the first time since August 21, 2019. (PHOTOS: Coady Photography)





Thoroughbreds remain the same, owner at time of foaling.
