A full field of 12 New Mexico-bred Thoroughbreds are entered in Sunday's 7-furlong, \$100,000 O.D. McDonald Stakes (R) at Albuquerque Downs.

Dale F. Taylor Racing's Golden Band (pictured), a homebred 6-year-old Quinton's Gold gelding trained by

Todd Fincher, will be stretching out in distance off of his half-length win in the 5 1/2-furlong, \$100,000 Casey Darnell Stakes (R) at Albuquerque Downs on August 21. Golden Band has won four of his six starts at Albuquerque.

Golden Band drew post 6 and will be ridden by Rodolfo Guerra. Other contenders include Ancient Land, a 4-year-old son of Monterey Jazz trained by Casey Lambert for owners Martin Riley, D. Carroll, C. Scott, and J. Howard. Ancient Land won two races during the recently concluded Ruidoso Downs meet, including the 7 1/2-furlong, \$50,000 Land of Enchantment Stakes (R) on July 31.

Ancient Land drew post 9 and will be ridden by Kelsi Purcell.

A field of six New Mexico-bred 3-year-old fillies, headed by multiple stakes winner Slammed (pictured), is entered in Saturday's 6 1/2-furlong, \$100,000 Petticoat Stakes (R) at Albuquerque Downs.



A homebred daughter of Marking owned by Fincher Racing LLC, Brad King, and Suzanne Kirby, Slammed brings in a three-race win streak that includes an 11-length victory in the 5 1/2-furlong, \$50,000 Sierra Starlet Stakes (R) at Ruidoso Downs on July 31, and a 4 1/2-length score in the 6 1/2-furlong, \$100,000 Carlos Salazar Stakes (R) at Albuquerque Downs on August 22. The bay filly drew post 5 and will be ridden by Tracy Hebert for trainer Todd Fincher.

Fincher will also send out two other Petticoat contenders, including Helen Nave's Comic Hot Toddy, a stakes-winning homebred Indian Firewater filly. Comic Hot Toddy has earned \$83,364 from five races, and her two wins include a five-length victory in last year's 5 1/2-furlong, \$134,000 Rio Grande Seniorita Futurity (R) at Ruidoso Downs.

Comic Hot Toddy will be making her first-ever start at Albuquerque Downs. The filly drew post 6 and will be ridden by Aldo Arboleda.

The 2023 NMSF QH Futurity will have an estimated gross purse of \$1 Million. You'll pay \$100 to nominate your foals of 2021 on November 1, 2021 with an additional yearling payment of \$250 on April 15, 2022. This investment will increase the value of your foals at next year's New Mexico Horse Breeders' Sale.

This will be the first million-dollar futurity restricted to New Mexico Breds in the history of New Mexico racing!

Broodmare Registration Form

Broodmare Registration is September 1st of the year the mare is bred.

The following penalties will apply after September 1st:

If you miss registering the broodmare by September 1st of the year of breeding, the penalty on the foal is \$350.00.

If you miss a second September 1st deadline, the penalty will be \$700.00.

If you miss a third September 1st deadline the penalty will be at the maximum of \$1,500.00.

If you pay a penalty, any younger foals out of that same broodmare will be covered under that penalty.

Export Broodmare Forms are Due Oct 1st

Export Broodmare Return Forms

Those that participated in the export broodmare program and took mares home out of state need to remember to submit their return forms as they start bringing their pregnant mares back to New Mexico to Foal. Fees do apply if a form is not on file prior to foaling.

Broodmare Return Form

Remember, you can start the NMHBA registration process the day your foal is

born! You **DO NOT** need to wait until you receive the QH or TB certificates. But remember the horse is **NOT** and official New Mexico Bred until the certificates have been finalized.



Starting with Quarter Horse foals born in 2019, the breeder of record will be whoever owned the mare at the time of **conception**. QH foals born prior to 2019 the breeder of record will still be owner of the mare at time of foaling.

Thoroughbreds remain the same, owner at time of foaling.
