Eighteen state-bred 3-year-old Quarter Horses are entered in Monday's 400-yard New Mexico Cup Derby (RG2) trials at Zia Park.

The 10 fastest qualifiers will meet in the \$145,000-est. New Mexico Cup Derby final on October 31.



Rex Wells' Bigg Dee (pictured, white cap headlines the second of two trials. A bay son of Big Daddy Cartel and a \$30,000 yearling purchase at the 2019 New Mexico-Bred Sale, the gelding brings in a four-race win streak that includes the 400-yard, \$203,000 Zia Derby (RG2) at Ruidoso Downs on July 31, and the 400-yard, \$238,000 New Mexico State Fair Derby (R) at Albuquerque Downs on September 19.

Bigg Dee has won eight of 13 starts — including five of seven at the 400-yard distance — and he has earned \$324,560. The gelding drew post 8 and will be ridden by Mario Delgado for trainer James Gonzales II.

Other prominent sophomores entered in the second heat include Mark and Annette McCloy's Hollyn Bootie and William and Mary Robertson's Icy Morning Breeze. A homebred daughter of Big Daddy Cartel trained by Trey Wood, Hollyn Bootie will be facing New Mexico-bred 3-year-olds off of her fourth-place finish, 2 1/2 lengths behind

winner Apollitical Daizies, in the 440-yard, \$440,000 All American Oaks at Ruidoso Downs on September 5.

Hollyn Bootie has earned \$226,744 from 10 outs. The filly drew post 3 and will be ridden by Tanner Thedford.

Icy Morning Breeze is coming off of a Ruidoso Downs summer campaign during which the homebred Winners Version filly banked \$56,551 from four races and scored a half-length victory in the inaugural 350-yard, \$91,000 Mountain Top Derby (R) on June 19. Icy Morning Breeze drew post 6 and will be ridden by Hector Aldrete for trainer Jackie Riddle.

Trainer Larry Chavez will send out Chicky Chicky Kai in the first heat. A chestnut daughter of Jess A Chicks owned by Mike G. Parker, the filly is coming off of a second-place finish, one length behind Bigg Dee, in the New Mexico State Fair Derby.

Jose E. Guzman's Flashin Fire (pictured), a sorrel son of champion First Moonflash, is one of 56 state-bred 2-year-old Quarter Horses entered in Sunday's 350-yard New Mexico Cup Futurity (G2) trials at Zia Park.

Flashin Fire was claimed by his current connections for \$10,000 at Remington Park in Oklahoma City on April 11. Since then, the gelding has won two of three starts, including the 400-yard, \$320,000 Zia Futurity (RG1) at Ruidoso Downs on August 1.

Flashin Fire drew post 8 and will be ridden by Juan Pulido in the last of six trials.

Dashin Approach, a homebred Mr Pyc To You gelding trained by Jorge Morales-Flores for owners George and Peggy Cobb, drew post 4 and will be ridden by Jaime Parga Leos in the fourth heat. Raced in two states, including Oklahoma, Dashin Approach has earned \$81,294 from six races, and his three wins include a three-quarter length victory in the 350-yard, \$113,000 New Mexico Breeders' Futurity (RG3) at SunRay Park on May 23.


Other prominent 2-year-olds entered in Sunday's trials include Holland Rock, a homebred son of Rock Solid Jess owned by Bob and Sissie McClure. A maiden after five races, Holland Rock has banked \$86,428, but the gelding is coming off of a second-place finish, 1 3/4 lengths behind winner HS Golden Eagle, in the 400-yard, \$396,000 New Mexico State Fair Futurity (RG3) at Albuquerque Downs on September 19.

Holland Rock drew post 7 and will be ridden by Noe Garcia Jr. for trainer Fred Danley in the second trial.

Fred Danley will also send out Cowboy Zulu, a homebred graded stakes placed Zulu Dragon gelding he co-owns in partnership with Chuck Sonnenberg. Cowboy Zulu's resume includes a second-place finish, a neck behind Flashin Fire, in the Zia Futurity.

Cowboy Zulu drew post 5 and will be ridden by Mario Delgado in the fourth heat.

You can **start** the NMHBA registration process the day your foal is born! You DO NOT need to wait until you receive the QH or TB certificates. But remember

the horse is NOT an official New Mexico Bred until the certificates have been finalized.

All foals MUST BE conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status. If a registered NM Broodmare in foal to a registered NM Stallion leaves the state of New Mexico

- this application and the \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the breeding year.
- if the application and \$500 fee are NOT received by the applicable deadline, there is a ten day grace period and then the fee increases to \$1,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.
- No fees are required, if the mare is consigned to an advertised sale out of the State of NM if this form is completed and returned to the NMHBA. The mare may then leave NM seven (7) days prior to the sale and must return to NM no later than seven (7) days after the completion of the sale for the foal she is carrying to maintain eligibility for NM Bred accreditation. If the Broodmare is not returned to NM, a grace period of ten (10) days will be granted for the \$500 fee to be paid for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.

Starting with Quarter Horse foals born in 2019, the breeder of record will be whoever owned the mare at the time of **conception**. QH foals born prior to 2019 the breeder of record will still be owner of the mare at time of foaling.

Thoroughbreds remain the same, owner at time of foaling.
