PLEASE VOTE FOR OR AGAINST ON THE FOLLOWING FOUR ITEMS:

1. PROPOSED BY-LAW CHANGE FOR THOROUGHBRED BROODMARES

Any Thoroughbred mare, can enroll in her lifetime foal out a baby by an out of state Thoroughbred stallion, and that foal can be registered NM bred if the following conditions are met:

- The mare must foal in NM.
- She must be bred back to a NMHBA registered Thoroughbred stallion and produce a baby that lives long enough to be registered as a NM Bred. The mare has 2 years after the foal by the out of state Thoroughbred stallion is born to accomplish this. If the mare fails to produce another baby, dies, etc., the foal by the out of state Thoroughbred stallion is not eligible to be NM Bred.
- The mare must be registered with the NMHBA prior to foaling. The proposed "one fee" shall be waived.

This rule change would begin for foals being born in 2023. It would automatically sunset after 3 years unless the Rule Change is extended upon approval of NMHBA membership at the Annual Membership Meeting or through a Special Membership Meeting in 2026.

If this proposed By-Law change is approved by the membership, this language would be added to Article II Definition of the By-Laws.

2. PROPOSED BY-LAW CHANGES FOR RECIPIENT MARES

A Recipient Broodmare that is carrying an embryo by a New Mexico registered stallion, may leave the state of New Mexico, must enroll in the Embryo Broodmare Program, pay the \$500.00 fee, and not be required to return to NMHBA to foal for the following years of 2022, 2023, & 2024.

The Donor Mare must be in the Registry and the embryo transfer must take place in New Mexico. Both the Donor Mare and the Recipient Mare must be entered into the Broodmare Registry. This program will sunset in 2024 and then the membership will have to vote again in order for it to continue.

If this proposed By-Law change is approved by the membership, this language would be added to Article II - Definition of the By-Laws.

You can start the NMHBA registration process the day your foal is born! You DO NOT need to wait until you receive the QH or TB certificates. But remember the horse is NOT an official New Mexico Bred until the certificates have been finalized.

EXPORTING BROODMARES



All foals MUST BE conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status.

If a registered NM Broodmare in foal to a registered NM Stallion leaves the state of New Mexico:

- The application and the \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the breeding year.
- If the application and \$500 fee are NOT received by the applicable deadline, there is a ten day grace period and then the fee increases to \$1,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.

No fees are required if the mare is consigned to an advertised sale out of the State of NM if the form is completed and returned to the NMHBA.

The mare may then leave NM seven (7) days prior to the sale and must return to NM no later than seven (7) days after the completion of the sale for the foal she is carrying to maintain eligibility for NM Bred accreditation.

If the Broodmare is not returned to NM after a sale, a grace period of ten (10) days will be granted for the \$500 Export Broodmare Registration fee to be paid for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.

Starting with Quarter Horse foals born in 2019, the breeder of record will be whoever owned the mare at the time of conception. QH foals born prior to 2019 the breeder of record will still be owner of the mare at time of foaling.

Thoroughbreds remain the same, owner at time of foaling.
