ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS

- 1) Per NM Livestock Board
 - a) Vaccination must occur within ten (10) days of the pre-vaccination EVA blood test. (NMAC 21.30.7.19)
 - b) A copy of the EVA Test Laboratory Report must be filed with this EVA Vaccination Certificate.
- 2) All active stallions registered with the New Mexico Horse Breeders Association will be required to be vaccinated for EVA in subsequent years.
- 3) All shedder stallions are subject to rules and regulations promulgated by the New Mexico Livestock Board.
