## WHISKY ROAD GEMOLOGIST

On Wednesday at Turf Paradise, a pair of New Mexico-bred 2-year-olds qualified to the April 27, \$75,000-est. AQRA President's Open Spring Futurity.

Juan Macias' Whisky Road, a gelded son of Woodbridge and an \$8,000 yearling purchase from breeders Terry and Nan Lane, posted the second-fastest qualifying time, while Jose Aguilar Mendoza's Gemologist, a Jess A Chicks gelding and a \$9,000 yearling buy from breeder Mikkelson Racing LLC, recorded the fourth-fastest trial time. Nineteen Crimes (pictured) and Surfers Nightmare carried the colors of New Mexico with pride at Turf Paradise on Tuesday, as the New Mexico-Bred Sale graduates posted the fastest and second-fastest qualifying times, respectively, to the April 28, \$120,000-est. Desert Classic Futurity (R). The \$97,000 sale-topper from the consignment of breeder MJ Farms, Nineteen Crimes was ridden by Martin Osuna for owner Ricardo Ramirez and trainer Rigoberto Guillen, while Surfers Moon -- a \$33,000 purchase from breeders Dosi and Norma Alvarez -- was ridden by Alex Carrillo for owner Jose Aguilar Mendoza and trainer Eloy Navarro.

## SAVE MONEY!!

You can start the NMHBA registration process the day your foal is born!

You DO NOT need to wait until you receive the AQHA or Jockey Club certificates!

### Online NM Bred Application

But remember the horse is NOT an official New Mexico Bred & CANNOT run in a NM Bred race until the certificates have been finalized by our office.

*AQHA papers must be stamped in our office.  
Jockey Club papers are "stamped" online.*



## EXPORTING BROODMARES

**All foals MUST BE conceived  
and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status.**

If a registered NM Broodmare in foal to a registered NM Stallion leaves the state of New Mexico:

- The application and the \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the breeding year.
- If the application and \$500 fee are NOT received by the applicable deadline, there is a ten day grace period and then the fee increases to \$1,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM

Bred status.

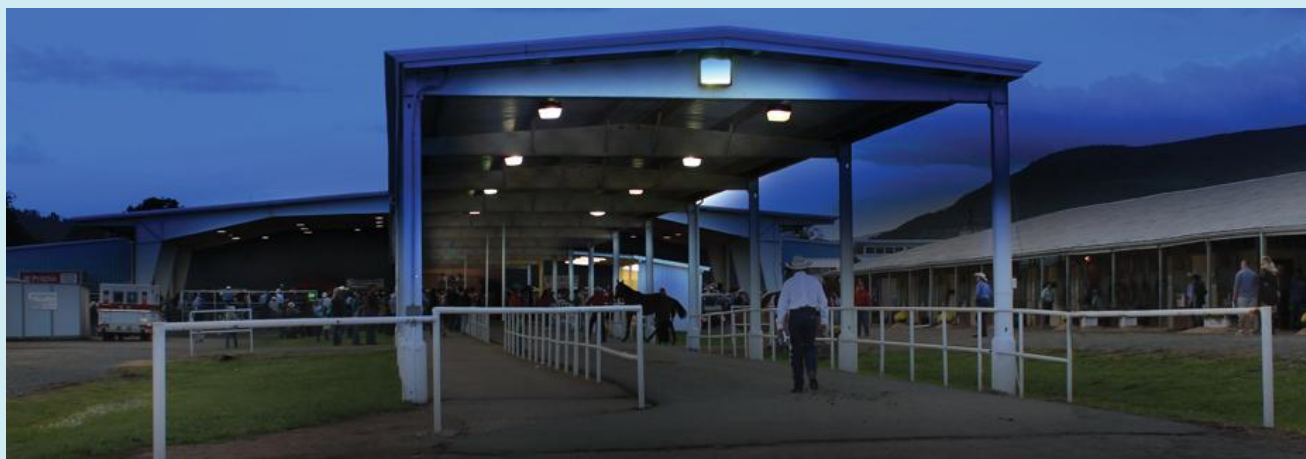
- Every donor mare and every recipient mare that is taken to board out of state must have their own form filled out and you must pay \$500.00 for each or the larger \$1,000 penalty if the October 1 deadline is missed.

**EXPORT BROODMARE  
RETURN FORMS BEGINNING WITH 2022 FOALS  
ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED!**

**You must still fill out the Export Form and pay \$500 per mare by October 1!**

## **MARES CONSIGNED TO A SALE**

- No fees are required if the mare is consigned to an advertised sale out of the State of NM if the form is completed and returned to the NMHBA.
- The mare may then leave NM seven (7) days prior to the sale and must return to NM no later than seven (7) days after the completion of the sale for the foal she is carrying to maintain eligibility for NM Bred accreditation.
- If the Broodmare is not returned to NM after a sale, a grace period of ten (10) days will be granted for the \$500 Export Broodmare Registration fee to be paid for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.

**The seller or buyer must notify the New Mexico Horse Breeders Association on the status of the broodmare in foal within seven days after the completion of the sale for the foal she is carrying to maintain eligibility for accreditation.**
