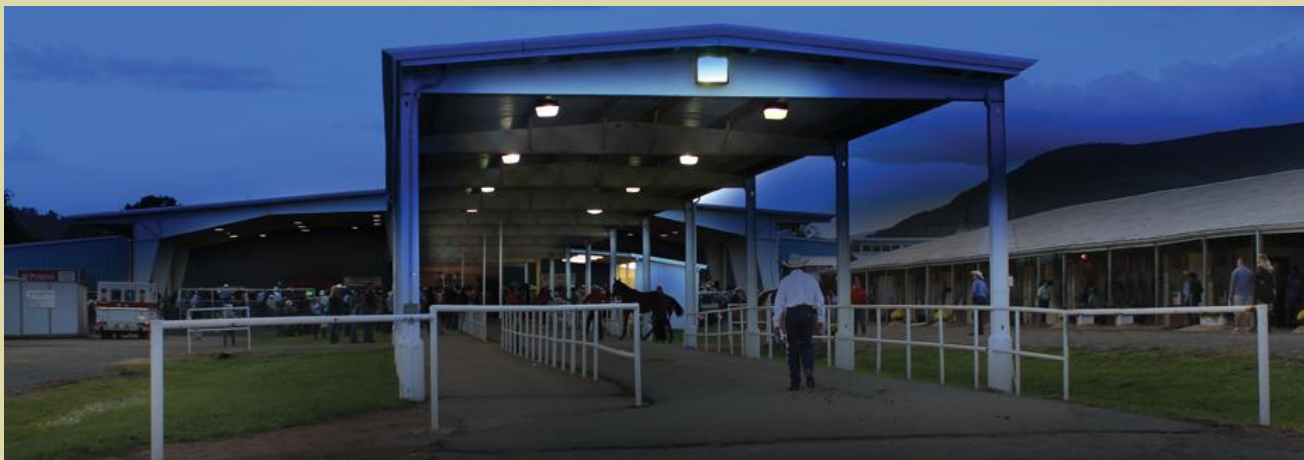

Sent to post at odds of 13-1, River Flash scored a three-quarter length victory in Sunday's \$100,000 New Mexico Breeders' Stakes (RG3) for state-bred sophomores at SunRay Park.

River Flash covered 400 yards in :19.599 while aided by a reported 12-mph tail wind. Adrian Ramos rode the gray Chicks Regard gelding for owners Robert M. Driggers and Ben Lee Ivey, and trainer Wes Giles.

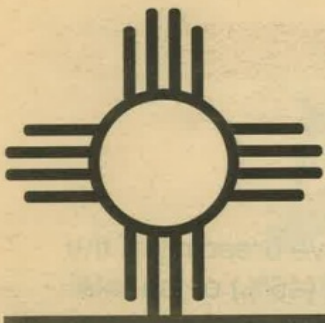

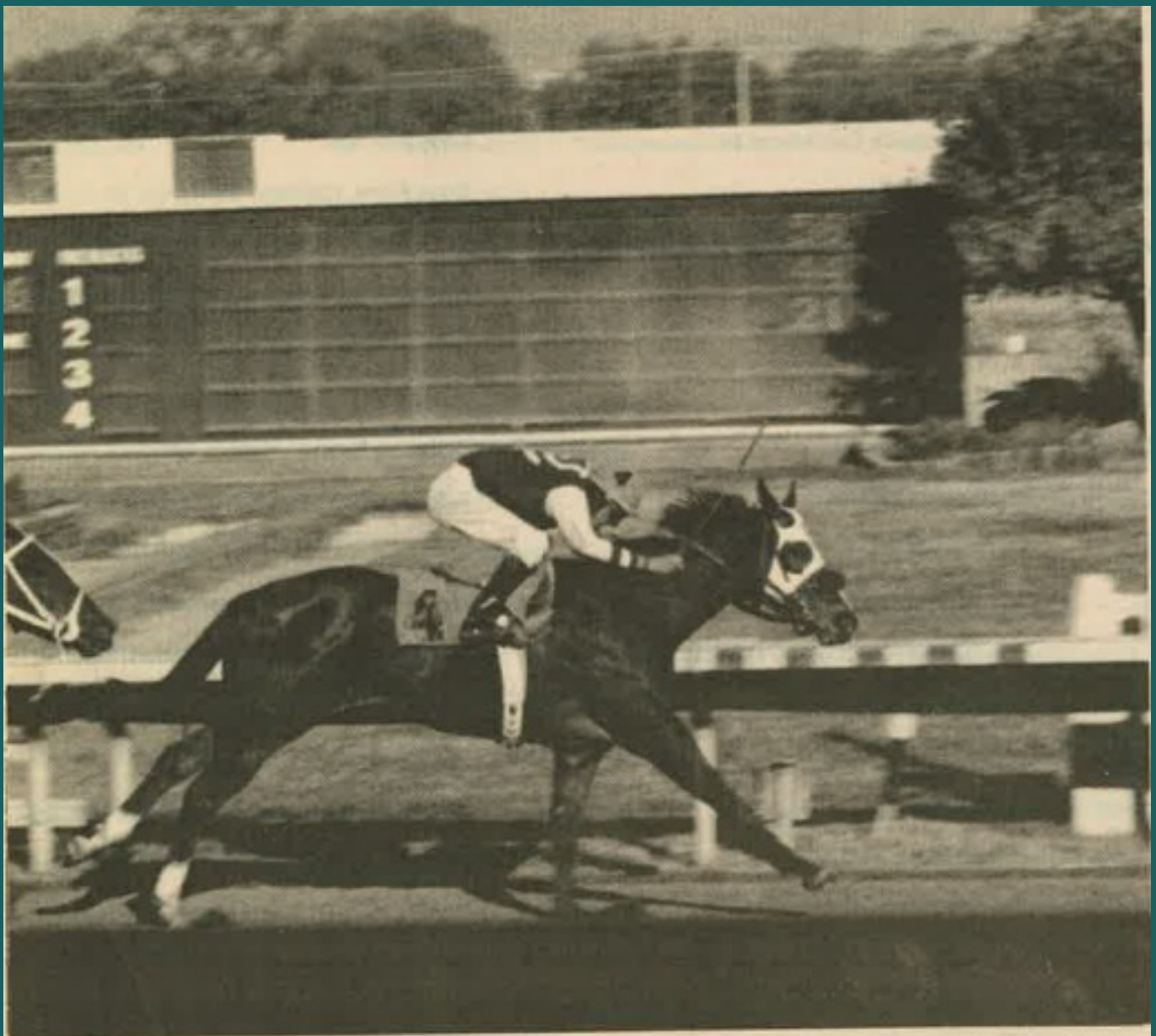

## MAJOR RIME ROLLS TO VICTORY IN NM BREEDERS' DERBY

Major Rime, the awesome 3-year-old son of Rime out of Mary Major, dusted the field in the \$70,755.21 New Mexico Breeders' Derby by 2 1/4 lengths at the New Mexico State Fair.

Guided by regular rider Bobby Don Harmon for trainer Robert Driggers, Major Rime covered the 400 yards in :19:82 under wraps. "I never uncocked my stick," said Harmon in the winner's circle. "He is running like his old self again, and can really roll once he got clear at the break."

Major Rime was voted 3-year-old of the Meet, and tied with Special Phoebe for Quarter Horse Of The Meet.

Robert Driggers who also bred and owns Major Rime, said, "We'll take him to Sunland for a little while and then he's going to Retama to run. He's training super and running great."

Johnnys Madam was a neck in front of Nathans Rocket, who in turn was a neck in front of Glass Mind. The photo for place and show was very close, but Major Rime was set on cruise control for an easy win and added \$35,377 to his bank roll.





## NOW I KNOW SCORCHES FIELD IN SENOR FUTURITY

Local Hope after a scorching 350 yard tune-up score two weeks ago. After winning his first six of seven lifetime showings, Now I Know added a big one in the form of the \$80,665 Senior Futurity at 400 yards. Recording the second best qualifying time of 20:10, Now I Know bettered that time with a 20:08 seconds on the fast track. Owned by Harper & Isler and trained by Lonnie Barber, Now I Know pushed his career earnings past the \$125,000 mark with the Senior score. Now I Know broke smartly under jockey Todd Fincher and despite jumping a shadow mid-way down the lane, managed a 3/4 length victory as the public's pick. A Red Storm Rising was a solid runner-up with Chris Zamora as Tonto Bars Dash took third money with Casey Lambert. The Senior was an attraction for top two year old colts and geldings that were bred in New Mexico.





## PROUD AND JIVEY SCORES IN GEORGE MALOOF FUTURITY

More than \$73,000 was up for grabs in the George Maloof Futurity Sunday at the New Mexico State Fairgrounds as Rita Danley's Proud And Jivey held off Wampuscat for a game score in the Futurity event. After a seesaw battle for the early pace, Proud And Jivey took off in the final quarter mile in the coveted race under Billy Peterson for trainer Fred Danley. Bred in New Mexico by his owner, Proud And Jivey posted a solid time of 1:10 2/5 for the fast track six furlong fun. Highly regarded Wampuscat held second as Frieda's Folly managed third. Proud And Jivey pushed his career earnings past the \$75,000 mark from just 7 trips to the gate.

The New Mexico State Fair Racing Assoc. paid tribute to trainer William Thompson who passed away two weeks ago by presenting the William A. Thompson Memorial at 400 yards. Thompson was one of the State's highly respected trainers and held records for most wins at Albuquerque, Ruidoso and Sunland Park during his 42 year reign. In 1972, Thompson was the 2nd leading trainer in the Nation. In tribute to the great trainer, Shut Up And Deal, one of his trained runners was retired from racing Sunday after an accomplished racing career. Regal Nita won the Memorial dash in a time of 20:01 with Tony Gallegos aboard. ❖

***AQHA papers must be stamped in our office.  
Jockey Club papers are "stamped" online.***

## **EXPORTING BROODMARES**

**All foals MUST BE conceived  
and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status.**

**If a registered NM Broodmare in foal to a registered NM Stallion  
leaves the state of New Mexico:**

- **The application and the \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the breeding year.**
- **If the application and \$500 fee are NOT received by the applicable deadline, there is a ten day grace period and then the fee increases to \$1,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.**
- **Every donor mare and every recipient mare that is taken to board out of state must have their own form filled out and you must pay \$500.00 for each or the larger \$1,000 penalty if the October 1 deadline is missed.**

**EXPORT BROODMARE  
RETURN FORMS BEGINNING WITH 2022 FOALS  
ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED!**

**You must still fill out the Export Form and pay \$500 per  
mare by October 1!**

## MARES CONSIGNED TO A SALE

- No fees are required if the mare is consigned to an advertised sale out of the State of NM if the form is completed and returned to the NMHBA.
- The mare may then leave NM seven (7) days prior to the sale and must return to NM no later than seven (7) days after the completion of the sale for the foal she is carrying to maintain eligibility for NM Bred accreditation.
- If the Broodmare is not returned to NM after a sale, a grace period of ten (10) days will be granted for the \$500 Export Broodmare Registration fee to be paid for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.

**The seller or buyer must notify the New Mexico Horse Breeders Association on the status of the broodmare in foal within seven days after the completion of the sale for the foal she is carrying to maintain eligibility for accreditation.**

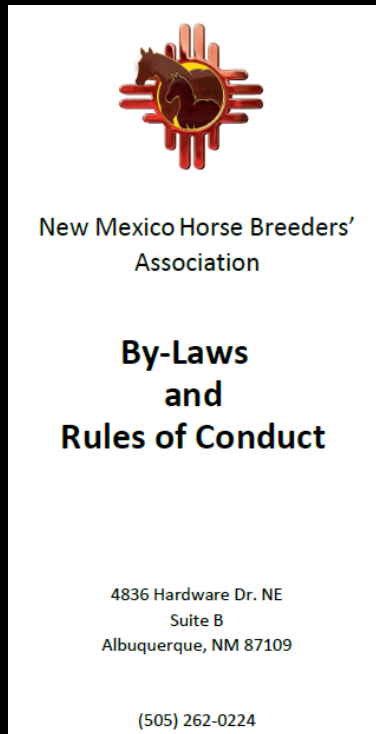

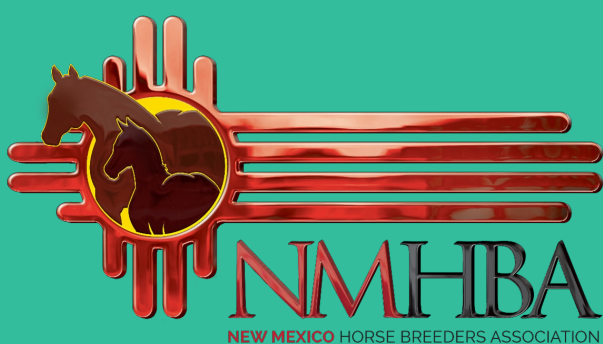

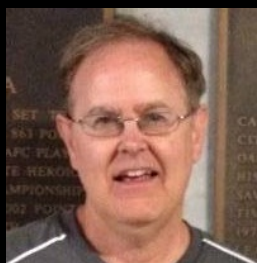
