As a trustee of the NMHBA, she is committed to facing the challenges of our industry and working diligently to advance horse racing in New Mexico.

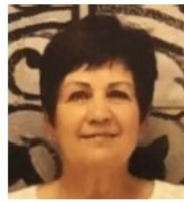


ROGER HOLLAND

EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW STALLIONS

All stallions MUST have a negative EVA test and be vaccinated for EVA within 10 days of the COLLECTION date according to the rules of the New Mexico Livestock Board before you can register them in the **NM Permanent Stallion Registry.**

Neiman (QH)

All NM registered stallions must have an annual EVA booster vaccination. Per NM Livestock Board regulations, they must be quarantined for 28 days after receiving the booster because it is a live virus and can be passed to other horses.

The deadline to turn in the EVA Booster Certificate to our office is February 1, 2023.

DON'T FORGET!!!

MARES IN FOAL CONSIGNED TO A SALE

- No fees are required if the mare is consigned to an advertised sale out of the State of NM if the form is completed and returned to the NMHBA.
- The mare may then leave NM seven (7) days prior to the sale and must return to NM no later than seven (7) days after the completion of the sale for the foal she is carrying to maintain eligibility for NM Bred accreditation.
- If the Broodmare is not returned to NM after a sale, a grace period of ten (10) days will be granted for the \$500 Export Broodmare Registration fee to be paid for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.

**The seller or buyer must notify the
New Mexico Horse Breeders
Association on the status of the
broodmare in foal within seven days
after the completion of the sale for the
foal she is carrying to maintain
eligibility for accreditation!**

**ROSE'S DESERT
Stakes Winning Mare of
\$626,035!**



Sent to post as the 3-10 choice, Rose's Desert rallied to win the 6-furlong, \$85,000 New Mexico State Racing Commission Handicap (R) for state-bred distaffers at Sunland Park on December 9.

Rose's Desert covered her three-quarter mile trip in 1:11.02 under jockey Casey Lambert, and her margin of victory was five lengths from runner-up Gossip Dome. Todd Fincher saddled the homebred 5-year-old mare by Desert God for owner Joe Peacock.

Rose's Desert is one of 22 stakes winners from 150 starters sired by Desert God, an unraced son of the Mr. Prospector stallion Fappiano and a half brother to Grade 2 winners Better Than Honour and Smolensk, and Grade 3 winner Turnberry Isle. Now 22, Desert God has sired the earners of more than \$10.5 million, including stakes winners Peppers Pride, Iplaytricks, Desert Hennessy, Attitude E Racer, and On Down The Road.

Desert God is owned by Dale Taylor, Joe Allen, and Ron Allen, and he will stand the 2013 season at Fred and Linda Alexander's A & A Ranch in Anthony, New Mexico.

Rose's Desert is also one of two winners from as many starters produced by Miss Glen Rose, a 12-year-old daughter of the Mt. Livermore stallion Peaks And Valleys. The filly's third dam, Pert, was an Ohio-bred mare by 1967 U.S. Horse of the Year Damascus who won the Grade 3 First Flight Handicap at Aqueduct in '83.

Rose's Desert was coming off of a second-place finish to Iplaytricks in the 1-mile, \$170,360 Peppers Pride New Mexico Cup Fillies & Mares Championship (R) at Zia Park on October 28. All told, the filly has banked \$420,825 from 10 races, and her seven victories include last year's 5 1/2-furlong, \$100,000 La Coneja Handicap (R) at Sunland Park, and the 2011 New Mexico State Racing Commission Handicap at Sunland and Peppers Pride New Mexico Cup Fillies & Mares Championship (R).

Rose's Desert returned a \$2.60 win mutuel and teamed with Gossip Dome, a 14-1 longshot, for a \$2 exacta payoff of \$16.60. Iplaytricks finished third, five lengths behind the winner, to complete a \$38.80 (\$1) trifecta.

Our Flying Angel, Driving Miss Dom, I Am Lesters Gal, Funnyoushouldask, and Dream Kin completed the order of finish.

A 5-year-old chestnut mare by the Storm Cat stallion Dome, Gossip Dome races for Pesikan and Kilgroe Stables. Gossip Dome has won six of 24 starts, and the \$18,700 second-place share of the New Mexico State Racing Commission Handicap purse pushed her earnings to \$133,109. The mare's stakes resume includes third-place runs in the August 26, \$50,000 Carlos Salazar Handicap (R) at The Downs at Albuquerque, and the July 29, \$50,000 Lincoln Handicap (R) at Ruidoso Downs.

Iplaytricks was making her first start since October 28, when the 5-year-old brown daughter of Desert God scored a one-length victory from Rose's Desert in the Peppers Pride New Mexico Cup Fillies & Mares Championship (R) for her owner, Michael C. Stinson of Fort Worth, Texas. The mare has won eight of 18 races, including four stakes, and has banked \$359,540. ♦

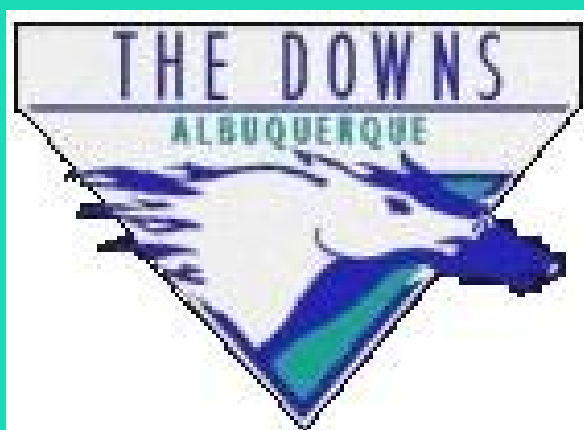
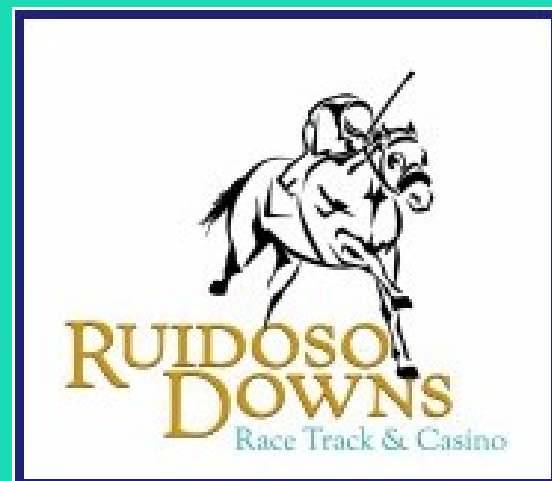

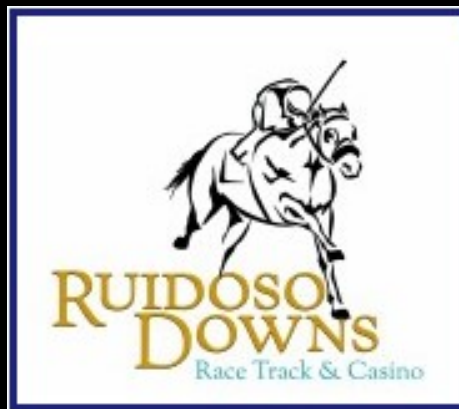

EXPORTING BROODMARES

All foals **MUST BE** conceived
and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status.

If a registered NM Broodmare in foal to a registered NM Stallion leaves the state of New Mexico:

- The application and the \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the breeding year.
- If the application and \$500 fee are NOT received by the applicable deadline, there is a ten day grace period and then the fee increases to \$1,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.
- Every donor mare and every recipient mare that is taken to board out of state must have their own form filled out and you must pay \$500.00 for each or the larger \$1,000 penalty if the October 1 deadline is missed.

EXPORT BROODMARE RETURN FORMS BEGINNING WITH 2022 FOALS ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED!

You must still fill out the Export Form and pay \$500 per mare by October 1!

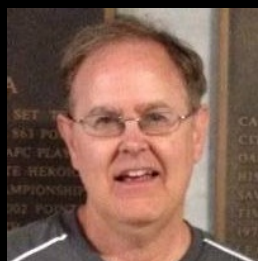
