

STALLION EVA REQUIREMENTS

EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW STALLIONS

All stallions MUST have a negative EVA test and be vaccinated for EVA within 10 days of the COLLECTION date according to the rules of the New Mexico Livestock Board before you can register them in the NM Permanent Stallion Registry.

EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR STALLIONS IN OUR REGISTRY

All NM registered stallions must have an annual EVA booster vaccination.

Per NM Livestock Board regulations, they must be quarantined for 28 days after receiving the booster because it is a live virus and can be passed to other horses. The deadline to turn in the EVA Booster Certificate to our office was February 1, 2023. Please call our office ASAP if you have not returned your booster form yet.

ZIA PARK MEET RECAP



"Zia Park ended its 2022 Thoroughbred and Quarter Horse meet on December 20.

Highlights from Zia Park's 48-day season included the 18th annual New Mexico Cup Day, October 30, and the track's annual all-Thoroughbred "Land of Enchantment Day" program on November 22. New Mexico Cup Day featured 12 state-bred stakes -- eight for Thoroughbreds and four for Quarter Horses -- and offered \$1,816,445 in purses. The richest New Mexico Cup race, the 350-yard, \$350,730 New Mexico Cup Futurity (RG2) for state-bred Quarter Horses, was won by MRB Racing LLC's First Lady On Canvas. Xavier Rodriguez trained, and Esgar Ramirez rode the homebred daughter of champion First Moonflash..."

You don't have to wait for your AQHA or Jockey Club papers to submit a New Mexico Bred application for your foals!
All foals MUST BE conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status.

Remember the horse is NOT an official New Mexico Bred & CANNOT run in a NM Bred race until the certificates have been finalized by our office.

AQHA papers must be stamped in our office. Jockey Club papers are "stamped" online.

OWNERS

Due to a NM State statute, all owners running a New Mexico Bred on the track must become a 2023 member of NMHBA within 90 days of placing 1st, 2nd, or 3rd if not a 2023 member already!!

All memberships expire December 31 each year.

If you do not comply you will forfeit your 2023 Award Distribution checks in November!!

Request for Broodmares in Foal to Leave the State of New Mexico for Sale

All foals MUST BE conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status.

If a registered NM Broodmare in foal to a registered NM Stallion leaves the state of New Mexico:

- The application and the \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the breeding year.
 If the application and \$500 fee are NOT received by the applicable deadline, there is a ten day grace period and then the fee increases to \$1,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.
- Every donor mare and every recipient mare that is taken to board out of state must have their own form filled out and you must pay \$500.00 for each or the larger \$1,000 penalty if the October 1 deadline is missed.

EXPORT BROODMARE RETURN FORMS BEGINNING WITH 2022 FOALS ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED! You must still fill out the Export Form and pay \$500 per mare by October 1!
