EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW STALLIONS

All stallions MUST have a negative EVA test and be vaccinated for EVA within 10 days of the COLLECTION date according to the rules of the New Mexico Livestock Board before

you can register them in the NM Permanent Stallion Registry.

NM Permanent Stallion Registry Form



All NM registered stallions must have an annual EVA booster vaccination. Per NM Livestock Board regulations, they must be quarantined for 28 days after receiving the booster because it is a live virus and can be passed to other horses.

The deadline to turn in the EVA Booster Certificate to our office was February 1, 2023.



La Coneja Stakes \$100,000 Guaranteed Fillies & Mares 4 Year Olds & Up 6 Furlongs Sunday, February 5, 2023

"Bella Dona (pictured), a homebred Attila's Storm filly racing for Robert Driggers, Del Rae Driggers, and Ben Lee Ivey, will make the first start of her 4-year-old campaign in Sunday's 6-furlong, \$100,000 La Coneja Stakes (R) for New Mexico-bred distaffers.

A winner of 10 stakes during her 2- and 3-year-old seasons, Bella Dona is coming off of a wire-to-wire, 3 1/4-length victory in the October 30, \$125,000 New Mexico Cup Oaks Championship (R) for state-bred 3-year-old fillies at Zia Park. All told, the filly has won 12 of 13 races — including three of three at Sunland Park — and she has earned \$750,068."

QUATRO MENUDOS Stakes Winner of \$300,386



SHUE FLY STAKES (RG1) Quatro Menudos

Quatro Menudos remained undefeated following his one-length victory in the \$313,502 Shue Fly Stakes (RG1) for New Mexico-bred newly turned 3-year-olds at Sunland Park on January 1.

Saddled by Hermenegildo "Poppy" Aldavaz for owners William McCarty, P. Wood, and SW Paving and Grading Inc., Quatro Menudos covered 400 yards in :18.979 while scoring his fourth win in as many starts. The \$147,346 winner's share of the purse increased the gray gelding's earnings to \$176,206.

"The start wasn't too rough – I was pretty much clear, and I let him go to the outside where he was fine and comfortable," said jockey Salvador Martinez, who has ridden Quatro Menudos in all of the gelding's outs. "I think he's an awesome horse.

"He did it really easy," he added. "I haven't asked him for much yet in his career."

A homebred, Quatro Menudos became the second stakes winner from two crops sired by Furyofthewind. An 8-year-old son of the Holland Ease stallion Corona Cartel, Furyofthewind won the 2006 AQHA California Derby Challenge (G3) at Los Alamitos. He is a half brother to four graded stakes winners, including champions Heartswideopen and Special Phoebe, and he has sired 29 starters and the earners of more than \$416,700, with Quatro Menudos representing his top earner to date.

Furyofthewind is owned by breeder Kirk

Goodfellow and stands for a \$2,000 fee at Bob Moore Farms at Norman, Oklahoma.

Quatro Menudo's dam, the Dash Ta Fame mare Uno Menudo, won the 2004 Zia Futurity (RG1) at Ruidoso Downs. Now 9, Uno Menudo is a half sister to Mas Frijoles, the runner-up to Quatro Menudos in this race.

Quatro Menudo's third dam, the winning Rocket Wrangler mare I'm A Wrangler, produced nine winners from 10 starters, including Grade 1 winner Ima Ladys Alibi, Grade 2 winner Raise A Count, and stakes winner Priss On Across.


The fastest qualifier, Quatro Menudos was coming off of a two-length victory in the first of six Shue Fly trials on December 17. He has been favored in three of his four races, and none of his winning margins has been less than one length.

Mas Frijoles ran second and was followed by Six Gun Regard, Love Mc Caliente, Hollywood Caliente, Running Miracle, Bedarinas Miracle RF, and Moro Moon. Sixth-fastest qualifier Might Be Southern and eighth-fastest qualifier See Mack The Knife were both scratched by the track veterinarian.

Also trained by Aldavaz for McCarty, Wood, and SW Paving and Grading Inc., Mas Frijoles has earned \$79,050 from two wins in three starts. The homebred sorrel gelding was coming off of a 1 ¹/₄-length victory in the fourth Shue Fly trial.


Six Gun Regard is a homebred bay gelding by Chicks Regard racing for KH Logax Inc. of Oro Valley, Arizona. Six Gun Regard has won one of 11 races and has banked \$79,093, and he was a finalist in last year's Zia (RG1), New Mexico Cup (RG2), and New Mexico State Fair Senor (RG3) futurities.

2011 Quarter Horse Three-Year-Old Colt/Gelding QUATRO MENUDOS



CHUCHULUCO Stakes Winner of \$570,360



JOHNIE L. JAMISON HANDICAP (R) Chuchuluco Ridden for the first time in a race by Justin Shepherd, Chuchuluco scored a onelength victory in the \$120,000 Johnnie L. Jamison Handicap (R) for New Mexicobreds at Sunland Park on December 12.

Chuchuluco covered 6 1/2-furlongs in 1:15.56 while earning his fifth win in nine starts and second career stakes victory. Todd Fincher saddled Chuchuluco for West Texas Racing Partners, which acquired the 3-yearold Devon Lane gelding for \$58,000 at the 2008 New Mexico-Bred Yearling Sale at Ruidoso Downs.

Chuchuluco was bred by Johnny and Mary Paiz, and the gelding is one of 11 stakes winners from 239 starters sired by Devon Lane, a winning son of Storm Cat whose 10 crops have earned more than \$7.5 million and include his top earner, River's Prayer, the winner of the 2007 Princess Rooney Handicap (G1) at Calder Racecourse in Florida. A half brother to Grade 1 winners Stellar Jayne and Starrer, Devon Lane stands for a \$2,500 fee at Terry and Nan Lane's TNL Farm at Bosque, New Mexico.

Chuchuluco is also one of three winners from four starters produced by Lady In Danger, an unraced daughter of the Siberian Express stallion In Excess (IRE). The 12year-old mare's starters include Dangerous Devon, a full brother to Chuchuluco who ran second in four stakes at Sunland Park and Zia Park from 2005-07. Chuchuluco's second dam, the winning Lord Gaylord mare Lady Danger, ran second in the '87 USF&G Maryland Lassie Stakes (R) at Pimlico Racecourse in Baltimore. A 1985 foal who died in 2007, Lady Danger produced seven winners from nine starters, including Dangerous Prospect, a gelding by Allen's Prospect who ran third in the 1996 Central Washington Handicap at Yakima Meadows.

Chuchuluco traces back to his third dam, Danger Bearing. A 1975 Maryland-bred foal by the Rambunctious stallion Rollicking, Danger Bearing won two stakes in Maryland from 1977-78, and she produced three stakes-placed runners. Danger Bearing's full sister, Laughing Gull, won three stakes in New Jersey and Maryland in 1981. Another full sister, Queen's Reckoning, won the \$52,350 Miss Woodford Breeders' Cup Handicap at Monmouth Park in '89.

Campaigned exclusively in New Mexico, Chuchuluco has earned \$302,484. The gelding's stakes resume includes a 2 1/4length victory in the January 23, \$125,000 Pepsi Cola Stakes (R) at Sunland, and a 1 1/4-length win in the 2008 New Mexico Cup Juvenile Colts & Geldings Stakes (R) at Zia Park.

Smash Dancer, the 2-1 favorite, ran second and was followed by Romeos Wilson, Huntin The Trash, Lefty Who, Brax, Train Rider Blues, Our Choice, Double Smart, Blushing Fina, Some Ghost, and Runnin Red.

Smash Dancer is a homebred 3-year-old

gelding by the late Robyn Dancer racing for Barbara M. Coleman of Farmington, New Mexico. Smash Dancer has earned \$224,700 from 13 outs, and his five wins include the 6-furlong, \$182,690 New Mexico Cup Sprint Championship Stakes (R) at Zia Park.

A 12-year-old Jack Wilson owned by Rita J. Danley of Anthony, New Mexico, Romeos Wilson banked \$12,000 to push his earnings to \$851,221. Romeos Wilson has won 19 of 97 races, including the 5 ¹/₂furlong Casey Darnell Pony Express Stakes (R) at The Downs at Albuquerque on August 22. The gelding won the Johnnie L. Jamison Handicap in 2006 and '07.

Remember the horse is <u>NOT</u> an official New Mexico Bred & <u>CANNOT</u> run in a NM Bred race until the certificates have been finalized by our office.

AQHA papers must be stamped in our office. Jockey Club papers are "stamped" online.

EXPORTING BROODMARES

All foals MUST BE conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status.

If a registered NM Broodmare in foal to a registered NM Stallion leaves the state of New Mexico:

- The application and the \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the breeding year.
- If the application and \$500 fee are NOT received by the applicable deadline, there is a ten day grace period and then the fee increases to \$1,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.
- Every donor mare and every recipient mare that is taken to board out of state must have their own form filled out and you must pay \$500.00 for each or the larger \$1,000 penalty if the October 1 deadline is missed.

EXPORT BROODMARE RETURN FORMS BEGINNING WITH 2022 FOALS ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED!

You must still fill out the Export Form and pay \$500 per mare by October 1!
