LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Members,

The Board of Trustees voted to have two paper issues of our magazine this year. They will be the Summer and Stallion issues that come out in July and December. First of all, we now have mail in ballots, so you do not have to attend the meeting in order to vote or attend to vote for others by proxy. Another reason I believe is that we did not have anything controversial to vote on this year. It was suggested that we have the meeting wherever the horses are running and also to have the meeting in November or December which would be during Zia Park in Hobbs, New Mexico. January is foaling season and it is difficult to attend at that time.

These are all good arguments however we do have a Summer meeting in Ruidoso at the Sales Pavilion during Zia Festival weekend that we advertise well and we still only get between 15 to 20 people to attend. November and December happen to be the busiest time of year for the association staff with the incentive award checks going out and registrations pouring in. I really think the only way to get a lot of people to come to our meeting is to make them vote in person and to have something controversial on the ballot to vote on.

I would like to welcome Debra Laney back to the board as a Quarter Horse Trustee and Denise Chambliss as our new board member on the Thoroughbred side. Congratulations to those Trustees who were reelected.

President Goncharoff, 1st Vice President Norma Alvarez, and I set up our booth at AgFest that was held at the Santa Fe Convention Center on February 16th. We had home grown pecans from Norma's farm and pistachios from Tularosa along with our regular giveaways. We met a lot of great people including several of our legislators who we were able to discuss issues that concern our association and horseracing that are coming up during this legislative session.

View House Bill 459

We submitted House Bill 459 that would change the award distribution percentages by lowering the owner awards percentage from 40% to 35% and increasing the stallion owner awards from 7% to 12%. There has been some talk that the members were not included in this decision, but this was presented by Ralph Vincent during our annual meeting, and we also sent out a mass email to all 2022 and 2023 members that we had email addresses for, totaling 1,028 asking for their opinion. Out of the 656 people who opened this email, we only received 40 responses and there were 21 for the change and 19 against. This bill did pass through the first legislative committee and will be heard by a second committee this afternoon.

View Senate Bill 336

Senate Bill 336 was of a lot of concern to us initially but has been revised in a way that both the horsemen and breeders could live with. It still isn't perfect but according to the lawyers and lobbyists, it is the best we could get. This bill would take up to 4.6% of the 26% currently going to taxes from gaming to pay for the jockey and exercise riders insurance and for HISA and would sunset in three years to be reevaluated. This bill has a long way to go, so it may not get done this year, and in that case, we would still have the same issue of who is going to pay for these things. Thank you to Amber Martin, our registrar, who put all your emails in a booklet that was very well received by Senator Padilla and the other legislators on the committee.

View Senate Bill 410

Senate Bill 410 would give the racetracks the power to name their own race dates and would eliminate the current requirement of having at least one racetrack running in order for all five racetracks to have their casinos open. This bill has been scheduled to be heard by the Senate Tax, Business & Transportation Committee this Saturday, March 4, 2023 at 9:00 am in Room 311. We will keep you posted!



STALLION EVA REQUIREMENTS

EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW STALLIONS

All stallions MUST have a negative EVA test and be vaccinated for EVA within 10 days of the COLLECTION date according to the rules of the New Mexico Livestock Board before you can register them in the NM Permanent Stallion Registry.

EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR STALLIONS IN OUR REGISTRY

All NM registered stallions must have an annual EVA booster vaccination.

Per NM Livestock Board regulations, they must be quarantined for 28 days after receiving the booster because it is a live virus and can be passed to other horses. The deadline to turn in the EVA Booster Certificate to our office was February 1, 2023. Please call our office ASAP if you have not returned your booster form yet.



Handsome Jack Flash is AQHA Champion 2-Yr Old

Handsome Jack Flash, a New Mexicobred gelding by leading freshman sire First Moonflash, is the 2013 American Quarter Horse Association champion 2-year-old.

The announcement was made during the AQHA champions award ceremony at Heritage Place in Oklahoma City on January 22.

Racing for Debra J. Laney, Norma Alvarez, and Brenda Alvarez, Handsome Jack Flash earned \$1,482,271 from five starts, and his four wins included a neck victory in the 440-yard, \$2.6-million All American Futurity (G1) at Ruidoso Downs on September 2, and a half-length score in the 400-yard, \$409,434 Zia Futurity (RG1) at Ruidoso on July 28.

Handsome Jack Flash was bred by Laney, a resident of Tularosa, New Mexico. The brown gelding was one of only two Quarter Horses -- and the only 2-year-old

-- to earn more than \$1 million in 2013. The other, All American Derby (G1) winner Feature Hero, ended the season with \$1,290,050 in earnings and was voted AQHA champion 3-year-old and 3-year-old gelding.

The other 2013 AQHA racing champions are -- Last To Fire (world champion, aged gelding, and aged horse), Check N Fetch (aged mare), Feature Mr Bojangles (aged stallion), Brace For Bernal (3-year-old colt), Matabari (3-year-old filly), Kates Dynasty (2-year-old filly), Five Bar Cartel (2-year-old colt), Honoroso (distance champion), One Famous Episode (Mexico champion), Corderoy Road (Canada champion), Italia Gold (South America champion), Paul Jones (trainer), Cody Jensen (jockey), Burnett Ranches, LLC (breeder), and Johnny Trotter/Burnett Ranches, LLC (owner).

Here is how to figure what your horse will make on top of the purse in an

open overnight race:

Purse x 20% = ?
? x 63% for WIN
? x 24% for SECOND
? x 13% for THIRD

Example:

Purse \$15,000 x 20% = \$3,000

\$3,000 x 63% for WIN = \$1,890 added to your purse money \$3,000 x 24% for SECOND = \$720 added to your purse money \$3,000 x 13% for THIRD = \$390 added to your purse money

All foals MUST BE conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status.

Remember the horse is NOT an official New Mexico Bred & CANNOT run in a NM Bred race until the certificates have been finalized by our office.

AQHA papers must be stamped in our office. Jockey Club papers are "stamped" online.

OWNERS

Due to a NM State statute, all owners running a New Mexico Bred on the track must become a 2023 member of NMHBA within 90 days of placing 1st, 2nd, or 3rd if not a 2023 member already!!

All memberships expire December 31 each year.

If you do not comply you will forfeit your 2023 Award Distribution checks in November!!

Request for Broodmares in Foal to Leave the State of New Mexico for Sale

All foals MUST BE conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status.

If a registered NM Broodmare in foal to a registered NM Stallion leaves the state of New Mexico:

- The application and the \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the breeding year.
 If the application and \$500 fee are NOT received by the applicable deadline, there is a ten day grace period and then the fee increases to \$1,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.
- Every donor mare and every recipient mare that is taken to board out of state must have their own form filled out and you must pay \$500.00 for each or the larger \$1,000 penalty if the October 1 deadline is missed.

EXPORT BROODMARE RETURN FORMS BEGINNING WITH 2022 FOALS ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED!

You must still fill out the Export Form and pay \$500 per mare by October 1!
