LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

The following bills that impact the entire Horseracing Industry in New Mexico are still in process as of today, March 17, 2023:

Bill: HB390
Sponsors: Ezzell (R58)
Title: HORSE RACEHORSE TESTING FUND, FINES AND AUDIT
Summary: Amends the Horse Racing Act to (a) shift proceeds from civil penalty and testing fines for violations of the act from the School Fund to the Racehorse Testing Fund; (b) require that the Racehorse Testing fund be thoroughly examined and audited by an independent auditor approved by the State Auditor; and (c) specify that the State Racing Commission is authorized to impose a maximum \$100,000 fine for each positive test result under Sec. 60-1A-14 (drug testing) in addition to the authority it has to impose a \$100,000 civil penalty fine for a violation of other sections of the act.
Subjects: Gambling; Public Finance and Budgets; Agriculture and Ranching; Taxation, Fees and Audits

Bill: HB459
Sponsors: Lundstrom (D9)
Title: HORSE BREEDER AWARDS IN HORSE RACING
Summary: Increases the funds paid to the owners of the stallions that sired the first-place winners from 7% to 12% of the distributed money from the Horse Breeders' Association Fund under the Horse Racing Act.

Bill: SB336
Sponsors: Padilla (D14)
Title: RACING TRACK OPERATOR COST OFFSETS
Summary: Allows racetrack gaming operators ("racinos") to offset the mandatory 20% of profit allocated to racing purses with costs to the casino for jockey and exercise rider insurance, costs incurred to comply with federal racing laws and other costs permitted under state racing commissions rules.
Subjects: Gambling; Taxation, Fees and Audits

Bill: SB301
Sponsors: McKenna (D9); McQueen (D50)
Title: FREE ROAMING HORSES: WILD HORSE MANAGEMENT
Summary: Creates a procedure and process to assess and remove wild horses in certain circumstances (rewrite of SB 385 of 2021 Reg.). The new version of the bill includes different language but shares the same basic intent of ensuring ranges and state land don't become overpopulated with horses and that sick horses are cared for.

Bill: SB410
Sponsors: Burt (R33)
Title: RACETRACK GAMING OPERATOR LICENSURE CHANGES
Summary: Adds to the racetrack license application requirements and amends the circumstances under which a racetrack gaming operator's license can be voided.
Subjects: Gambling; State Affairs and State Agencies

Bill: SB330
Sponsors: Maestas (D26)
Title: RLD TO REGULATE HORSE RACING; ABOLISHES RACING COMMISSION
Summary: An Executive Reorganization measure that moves the regulation of horse racing to the Regulation and Licensing Department, abolishes the State Racing Commission, and effective July 1, 2024, transfers all functions, assets, statutory references and rules from the State Racing Commission to the Regulation and Licensing Department for the regulation of horse racing and the purposes of the Horse Racing Act
Subjects: Gambling; State Affairs and State Agencies; Business, Manufacturing and Economic Development

Bill: HB168
Sponsors: Cates (D44)
Title: NO SMOKING AT RACINOS
Summary: (Duplicate of 2023 HB168) Relates to health. Prohibits smoking at a racetrack that is licensed by the State Racing Commission with a gaming operator's license issued by the Gaming Control Board.
Subjects: Health and Medical Practice; Gambling; Business, Manufacturing and Economic Development; Alcohol, Firearms and Tobacco Products

Bill: SB130
Sponsors: Lopez (D11)
Title: NO SMOKING AT RACINOS
Summary: (For the Tobacco Settlement Revenue Oversight Committee) Relates to health. Prohibits smoking at a racetrack that is licensed by the State Racing Commission with a gaming operator's license issued by the Gaming Control Board.
Subjects: Health and Medical Practice; Business, Manufacturing and Economic Development; Alcohol, Firearms and Tobacco Products; Gambling

Bill: SB247
Sponsors: Ivey-Soto (D15); Castellano (D70)
Title: CHANGES TO UNIFORM LICENSING ACT
Summary: Makes several changes to the Uniform Licensing Act, most notably allowing virtual remote hearings and recording by digital technology; provides for summary suspension of a license; procedures relating to disciplinary action; vests staff with civil investigative subpoena authority; provides requirements relating to compacts; and increases the penalty from \$1,000 to \$10,000 for unlicensed activity.
Subjects: State Affairs and State Agencies; Business, Manufacturing and Economic Development

Bill: SB293
Sponsors: Maestas (D26)
Title: OFFERING FREE FOOD TO GAMBLERS
Summary: Allows gaming operators to offer food and "other products or services" for no charge or at a reduced price to entice people to gamble, excluding free alcohol.
Subjects: Gambling

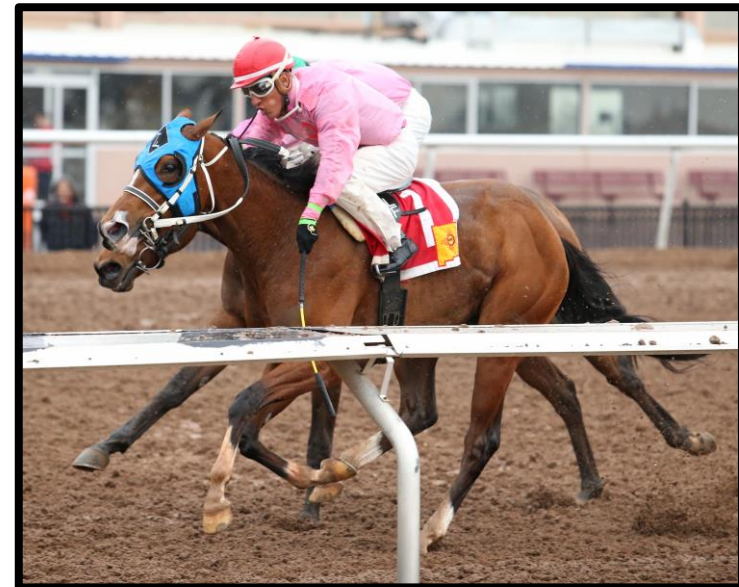

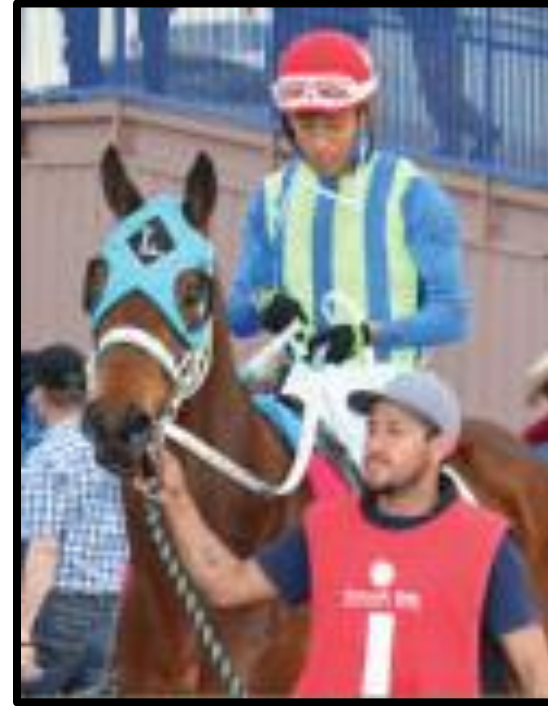

All NM registered stallions must have an annual EVA booster vaccination.

Per NM Livestock Board regulations, they must be quarantined for 28 days after receiving the booster because it is a live virus and can be passed to other horses. The deadline to turn in the EVA Booster Certificate to our office was February 1, 2023. Please call our office ASAP if you have not returned your booster form yet.

There was nothing 'rocky' about the ride turned in by Rocky Gulch in the \$87,386 Rio Grande Senior Futurity at Ruidoso on Zia Day.

Rocky Gulch broke from post 9, drew off out of the quarter and took it home from there—and he must have thought home was in Alaska! The youngster won the race by 15 lengths in a time of 1:02.00 for the five-and-a-half furlong distance.

The chestnut gelding is by Dry Gulch out of Rona Prospect by Allen's Prospect and was bred by his owner, Larry Teague of Hobbs, New Mexico. Rocky Gulch is trained by Terry Walker who legged up Mike Clark for the ride to earn \$43,694, which brings his lifetime earnings to \$85,369.

This boy has only run four races and he's won three of them, which includes two trial wins and he took a second in the Coppertop in April.

Hecamefromaclaim traded places with Rocky Gulch and claimed second for this one. Hecamefromaclaim won the Coppertop and Rocky came in second in April, but in the Rio Grande Senior, Hecamefromaclaim looked good in the lead for a while, then was just no match for the power drive of Rocky Gluch and held onto a good second. This In Excessive Bull gelding is out of Ringthatbelle and was bred by Joe Brooks. He's owned by Joe Dee and Lisa Brooks of Levelland, Texas and is conditioned by Todd Fincher, who put jockey Ricardo Jaime in the saddle to earn \$17,478. This win brings the total personal purse to \$109,535 for four races,

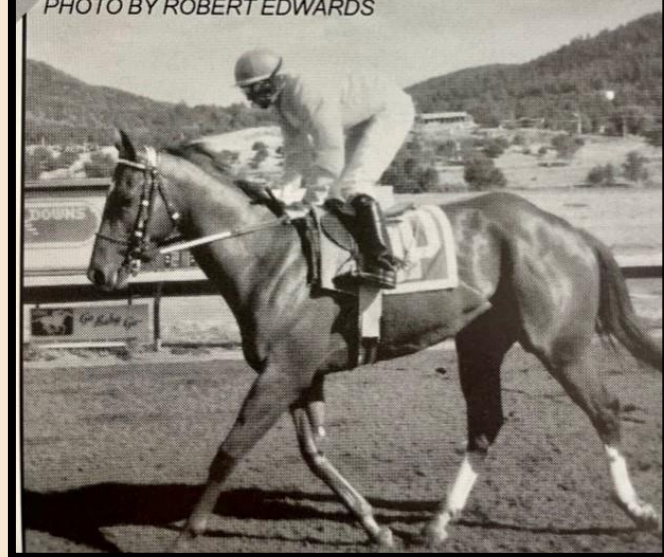
which include two wins and two seconds.

Third place was earned by Devons Gono Roll, a Devon Lane gelding out of the Bold Ego mare, Hearts R Gona Roll. Devons Gona Roll was bred by W.L. Mooring and Frank Richardson and is owned by SMS Racing LLC, Henry Southway, *et al.* The gelding is trained by Tony Sedillo and was ridden by jockey Alfredo Juarez, Sr. The team earned \$10,487 which brings the lifetime earnings for Devons Gona Roll to \$10,987. This is the third race for this youngster and his first stakes effort, also the first time he's come in for a top spot.

Bold Nxs, Danzafina, Danzin Tyson, Devon Special, Bombofalooker and Hasty's Devil followed the leaders. Some Ghost was scratched.

EXPORT BROODMARE FORMS



All foals **MUST BE** conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status.

If a registered NM Broodmare in foal to a registered NM Stallion leaves the state of New Mexico:

- The application and the \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the breeding year. If the application and \$500 fee are **NOT** received by the applicable deadline, there is a ten day grace period and then the fee increases to \$1,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.
- Every donor mare and every recipient mare that is taken to board out of state must have their own form filled out and you must pay \$500.00 for each or the larger \$1,000 penalty if the October 1 deadline is missed.
