# BEAT A NATIVE was also the sire of SAUCY NATIVE

## Multiple Stakes Winner of \$91,700

L. B. Cox's Saucy Native notched her third consecutive stakes triumph Sunday when she scored a sharp neck victory in the \$10,000 Tall Cotton Handicap at The Downs.

The 400 yard Tall Cotton is reserved for fillies and mares.

Breaking alertly under visiting jockey Mike Short, Saucy Native held off the furious late charge of runner-up Totally Native, Saucy Native and Totally Native finished one-two, respectively, in the recent Lineage Championship in Albuquerque. Sensuously finished third in the field of nine.

Following in second was Totally Native (Beat A Native-Totally A Lady) owned by Sonny Henderson trained by Richard Fry, ridden by Jimmy Coates. In third was Sensuously (Seward Junction-Streakin Judy) owned by Ben Devargas Jr.,

20

trained by Julian Devargas, ridden by Nancy Summers.

Saucy Native, a five-year-old New Mexico bred daughter of The Dash, has now captured nine of 33 career outings. She earned \$6,000 for the victory and extended her career bankroll above the \$100,000 plateau at \$102,066.

Saucy Native, who is trained by Richard Fry, covered the 400 yards in a fast final time of :19.79.

The remaining order of finish, beginning with fourth, was Miss Pyro Danish (Pyromaniac-Fols Danish); Splish Splash Dash (The Dash-Truly Bobbi); First Down Hussey (First Down Dash-Hot Blooded Hussy); If I Knew (Sail On Bunny-Sip O'Gold TB); Funistrada (Zevi TB-La Fete); and Rockettes Tonie (Sparkling Tony-Randee Rockette).

All stallions MUST have a negative EVA test and be vaccinated for EVA within 10 days of the COLLECTION date according to the rules of the New Mexico Livestock Board before you can register them in the NM Permanent Stallion Registry.

## EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR STALLIONS IN OUR REGISTRY

All NM registered stallions must have an annual EVA booster vaccination.

Per NM Livestock Board regulations, they must be quarantined for 28 days after receiving the booster because it is a live virus and can be passed to other horses. The deadline to turn in the EVA Booster Certificate to our office was February 1, 2023. Please call our office ASAP if you have not returned your booster form yet.

**Remember the horse is NOT an official New Mexico Bred & CANNOT run in a NM Bred race until the certificates have been finalized by our office.**

AQHA papers must be stamped in our office. Jockey Club papers are "stamped" online.

# OWNERS

**Due to a NM State statute, all owners running a New Mexico Bred on the track must become a 2023 member of NMHBA within 90 days of placing 1st, 2nd, or 3rd if not a 2023 member already!!**

**All memberships expire December 31 each year.**

# EXPORT BROODMARE FORMS



All foals **MUST BE** conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status.

If a registered NM Broodmare in foal to a registered NM Stallion leaves the state of New Mexico:

- The application and the \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the breeding year. If the application and \$500 fee are **NOT** received by the applicable deadline, there is a ten day grace period and then the fee increases to \$1,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.
- Every donor mare and every recipient mare that is taken to board out of state must have their own form filled out and you must pay \$500.00 for each or the larger \$1,000 penalty if the October 1 deadline is missed.
