





"A dozen state-bred 2-year-old Quarter Horses, led by fastest qualifier and graded stakes winner Crispyn (pictured), are entered back in Sunday's 400-yard New Mexico State Fair Futurity (RG2) at Albuquerque Downs.

This year's New Mexico State Fair Futurity will offer a stakes-record purse of \$1,208,668, making it the world's richest state-bred Quarter Horse futurity.

A homebred son of the Mr Jess Perry stallion A Royal Jess, Crispyn is trained by Manuel Rodolfo Rodriguez for owner MRB Racing LLC. The bay gelding made his local debut with a neck victory in the ninth of 15 State Fair Futurity trials on September 22. All told, Crispyn has earned \$261,885 from seven races, and his four wins include a neck victory in the April 1, \$366,000 New Mexican Spring Futurity (RG2) at Sunland Park. The gelding drew post 2 and will be ridden by Esgar Ramirez...."

"Fine Am Eye (pictured), a sorrel daughter of the Mr Jess Perry stallion Eye Am King racing for Backdoor Thoroughbreds LLC, is the fastest qualifier to the October 15, \$250,000-added New Mexico State Fair Derby (RG3) for state-bred 3-year-old Quarter Horses.

Racing in the last of six trials at Albuquerque Downs on Saturday, Fine Am Eye defeated third-fastest qualifier Pick Your Pour by a half of a length while covering 400 yards in :19.114, a clocking accomplished while aided by a reported 15-mph tail wind. Noe Garcia Jr. rode the filly for trainer Fred Danley.

Fine Am Eye was bred by Mac and Janis Murray's MJ Farms at Veguita, New Mexico, and she was a \$27,000 yearling purchase at the 2021 New Mexico-Bred Sale at Ruidoso Downs..."



DO YOU REMEMBER... FIRST MOONFLASH

"Owned by a partnership, First Moonflash stood his entire career at W.L. and Dee Mooring's Double LL Farm at Bosque, New Mexico. The son of champion First To Flash and the stakes-placed Major Rime mare Nagano Moon was bred in New Mexico by Dosi and Norma Alvarez, and he was campaigned by Pierre and Leslie Amestoy and Maria Gonzalez.

First Moonflash won 14 of 25 starts and earned \$969,828, and his 10 stakes wins included the Championship at Sunland Park (G1) in 2008 and '09, and the 2009 New Mexico Cup Championship (G1) at Zia Park. He was voted AQHA champion aged stallion after a 4-year-old campaign during which he won seven of eight outs, including six stakes, and banked \$491,040..."




DR. MATTHEW ROUNSEVILLE





You don't have to wait for your AQHA or Jockey Club papers to submit a New Mexico Bred application for your foals!
All foals MUST BE conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status.

Remember the horse is NOT an official New Mexico Bred & CANNOT run in a NM Bred race until the certificates have been finalized by our office.

AQHA papers must be stamped in our office. Jockey Club papers are "stamped" online.

OWNERS

Due to a NM State statute, all owners running a New Mexico Bred on the track must become a 2023 member of NMHBA within 90 days of placing 1st, 2nd, or 3rd if not a 2023 member already!!

All memberships expire December 31 each year.

If you do not comply you will forfeit your 2023 Award Distribution checks in November!!

Request for Broodmares in Foal to Leave the State of New Mexico for Sale

All foals MUST BE conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status.

If a registered NM Broodmare in foal to a registered NM Stallion leaves the state of New Mexico:

- The application and the \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the breeding year.
 If the application and \$500 fee are NOT received by the applicable deadline, there is a ten day grace period and then the fee increases to \$1,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.
- Every donor mare and every recipient mare that is taken to board out of state must have their own form filled out and you must pay \$500.00 for each or the larger \$1,000 penalty if the October 1 deadline is missed.

EXPORT BROODMARE RETURN FORMS BEGINNING WITH 2022 FOALS ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED! You must still fill out the Export Form and pay \$500 per mare by October 1!

EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR STALLIONS IN OUR REGISTRY

All NM registered stallions must have an annual EVA booster vaccination.

Per NM Livestock Board regulations, they must be quarantined for 28 days after receiving the booster because it is a live virus and can be passed to other horses. The deadline to turn in the EVA Booster Certificate to our office was February 1, 2023. Please call our office ASAP if you have not returned your booster form yet.
