



STALLION EVA FORM

The Stallion EVA forms are being mailed out next week.

The forms must be returned by February 1, 2024.

Contact your veterinarian ASAP to schedule your stallion's EVA vaccination!

They must request a vaccine for EACH stallion from the NM Livestock Board.

If not returned by the deadline, your stallion will be marked INACTIVE and it will cost \$200 to RE-ACTIVATE!!

EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR STALLIONS IN OUR REGISTRY

All NM registered stallions must have an annual EVA booster vaccination.

Per NM Livestock Board regulations, they must be quarantined for 28 days after receiving the booster because it is a live virus and can be passed to other horses.

EVA Booster Certification Form

EVA REQUIREMENTSFOR NEW STALLIONS

All stallions MUST have a negative EVA test and be vaccinated for EVA within 10 days of the COLLECTION date according to the rules of the New Mexico Livestock Board before you can register them in the NM Permanent Stallion Registry.

AWARD CHECKS




We are expecting to mail out the award checks on November 14, 2023.

All in a Day's Work for Perfect Call

good start to a perfect finish is what
Perfect Call got in the New Mexico State
Fair Quarter Horse Derby on September
21, 2003. The talented runner broke the
old track record of :19.34 set by Its Called
Splash on May 12, 2002, by 1-100th of a second.

Breaking from the five hole, Perfect Call broke in third, while Dial A Miracle on the inside rail took the early lead and LH Nobody Knows followed in second. Going into the stretch, Perfect Call and jockey James Gonzales wasted no time by quickly gaining speed to rally the field and cross the finish line in front by a neck, stopping the clock at :19.33. Xs Nitro, who was 10th at the start, covered a lot of ground to finish second while Hey Primer made a bid to finish third.

Owned and bred by Richard Shearer, Perfect Call was the fastest qualifier for this derby. Earning \$26,094 in this race, Perfect Call's record now stands at 12 starts with 5 wins, 3 seconds and one 3rd with total earnings of \$84,240. The Callighapher gelding out of Lost Dream by Six Fols, was sent to post by trainer Blane Wood.

and owner Rita Danley, bringing his career earnings to \$17,743. Conditioned by Fred Danley, the gelding by Caladon out of Little Diamondette by The Adamas was ridden to post by jockey Bonafacio Perez. In his last four outs Xs Nitro has finished no less than second.

Finishing third for the stake was Hey Primer, a bay gelding by Imprimatur and out of Incandescent by Beduino. He was bred by Mike Abraham and is owned by Leslie and Pierre Amestoy. Hey Primer is trained by Michael Joiner who put jockey G.R. Carter in the saddle to earn \$6,262 to bring his career total up to \$154,089.

The field was completed in the remaining order: Dial a Miracle, Crashed My Dooley, Nk Cee, Todos Al Banco, A Special First, Lh Nobody Knows and A Medley of Chicks.




ELISEO L. MONTOYA





All foals MUST BE conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status.

Remember the horse is NOT an official New Mexico Bred & CANNOT run in a NM Bred race until the certificates have been finalized by our office.

AQHA papers must be stamped in our office. Jockey Club papers are "stamped" online.

OWNERS

Due to a NM State statute, all owners running a New Mexico Bred on the track must become a 2023 member of NMHBA within 90 days of placing 1st, 2nd, or 3rd if not a 2023 member already!!

All memberships expire December 31 each year.

If you do not comply you will forfeit your 2023 Award Distribution checks in November!!

Tell your friends and continue to pass the word along!

The cut-off for award checks this year is the end of State Fair, so any races run after State Fair will be on NEXT year's checks!

Request for Broodmares in Foal to Leave the State of New Mexico for Sale

All foals MUST BE conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status.

If a registered NM Broodmare in foal to a registered NM Stallion leaves the state of New Mexico:

- The application and the \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the breeding year.
 If the application and \$500 fee are NOT received by the applicable deadline, there is a ten day grace period and then the fee increases to \$1,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.
- Every donor mare and every recipient mare that is taken to board out of state must have their own form filled out and you must pay \$500.00 for each or the larger \$1,000 penalty if the October 1 deadline is missed.

EXPORT BROODMARE RETURN FORMS BEGINNING WITH 2022 FOALS ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED! You must still fill out the Export Form and pay \$500 per mare by October 1!

STALLION EVA REQUIREMENTS

EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW STALLIONS

All stallions MUST have a negative EVA test and be vaccinated for EVA within 10 days of the COLLECTION date according to the rules of the New Mexico Livestock Board before you can register them in the NM Permanent Stallion Registry.

EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR STALLIONS IN OUR REGISTRY

All NM registered stallions must have an annual EVA booster vaccination.

Per NM Livestock Board regulations, they must be quarantined for 28 days after receiving the booster because it is a live virus and can be passed to other horses. The deadline to turn in the EVA Booster Certificate to our office was February 1, 2023. Please call our office ASAP if you have not returned your booster form yet.
