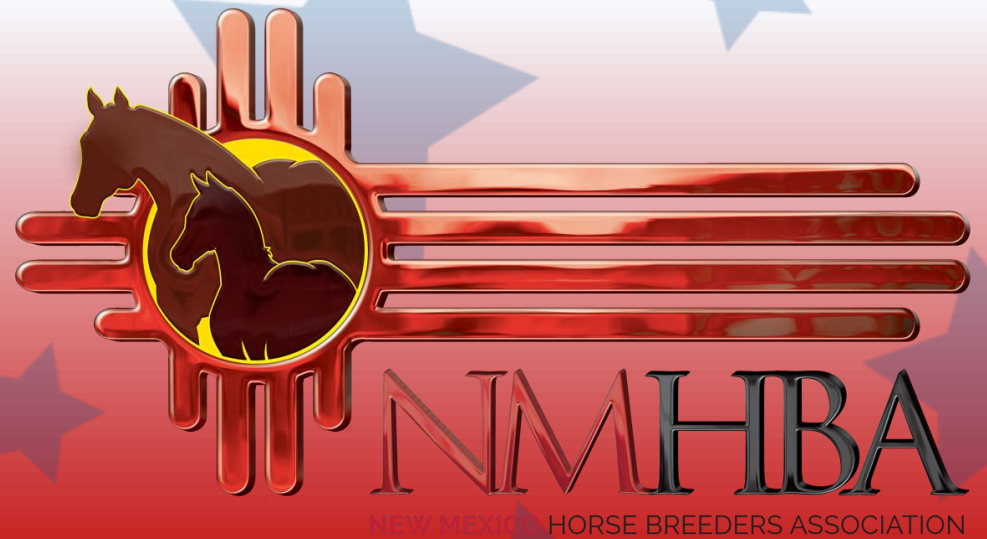

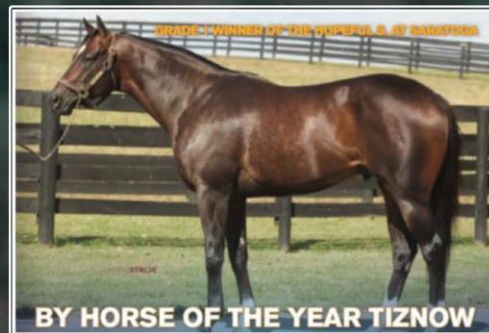

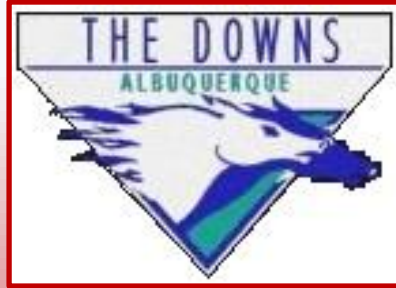

EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR STALLIONS IN OUR REGISTRY

All NM registered stallions must have an annual EVA booster vaccination. Per NM Livestock Board regulations, they must be quarantined for 28 days after receiving the booster because it is a live virus and can be passed to other horses.

EVA Booster Certification Form

EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW STALLIONS

All stallions **MUST** have a negative EVA test and be vaccinated for EVA within 10 days of the **COLLECTION** date according to the rules of the New Mexico Livestock Board before you can register them in the NM Permanent Stallion Registry.

Dear Mr. Trejo:

On February 2, 2024, Mr. Don Cook, the President of Racing at The Downs at Albuquerque forwarded you correspondence requesting that the New Mexico Racing Commission approve reducing two (2) race days and reducing weekend races from ten (10) races per day to nine (9) races per day.

Mr. Cook provided you with inaccurate and false information. For example, Mr. Cook projected that The Downs at Albuquerque would lose the following amounts wagered at The Downs at Albuquerque:

LOU WOOTEN HANDICAP (RG1)

Jenuine Joy

Jenuine Joy, a homebred 4-year-old mare racing for Fredda Draper of Ruidoso Downs, New Mexico, led at every call en route to a win in the Lou Wooten Handicap (RG2) for state-bred distaffers at Sunland Park on December 19.

Saddled by Draper's husband, Carl Draper, and ridden by Larry Payne, Jenuine Joy covered 400 yards in :18.907 to earn a 99 speed index. Her margin of victory was a half of a length from Lethal Delight, and the winner's share of the \$120,000 purse boosted her bankroll to \$179,400.

Blazin N Shakin, the 6-5 favorite, finished third, three-quarters of a length behind the winner.

Jenuine Joy is one of eight stakes winners from five crops sired by Genuine Strawfly. An 11-year-old son of the Special Effort stallion Strawfly Special, Genuine Strawfly won the All American (G1) and Ruidoso (G2) derbies in 2002, and his 154 starters have earned more than \$4.07 million and include his top earner, two-time Grade 1 winner One Diamond Kitty. Genuine Strawfly stands for a \$2,500 fee at Dr. Leonard Blach's Buena Suerte Equine at Roswell, New Mexico.

Jenuine Joy is also one of two winners from

three starters produced by Super Perla Negra, a winning 13-year-old daughter of the Coup de Kas (TB) stallion Super Duper Couper.

Jenuine Joy's half brother, the Desirio gelding CD Frontier Justice, was a finalist in this year's \$569,143 Ruidoso Derby (G1) at Ruidoso Downs.

Jenuine Joy's second dam, the winning Young Beduino mare Red Tag Sale, ran third in the 1993 Zia Freshman Handicap (R) at Ruidoso Downs. Her third dam, Real Easy Surprise, was a daughter of the Real Easy Jet stallion Realeasy Chick who won the 1989 Prescott Downs Derby (R) in Arizona and was a finalist in that season's Grade 2, \$74,120 West Texas Derby at Sunland Park.

Real Easy Surprise's four winners from six starters included Real Easy Celadon, a daughter of Celadon who won two stakes in New Mexico from 1999-2000 and was the New Mexico region high-point sophomore filly in '99. Real Easy Surprise was a half sister to two stakes-placed runners – Loose On The Lead, a Young Beduino gelding who ran second in the 1992 Hard Twist Stakes (R) at The Downs at Albuquerque, and Andy Andrew, a gelding by Celadon who ran second in the '98 Hard Twist Stakes.

DO YOU REMEMBER...

Racing exclusively in New Mexico, Jenuine Joy has won five of seven races, including the April 25, \$75,000 Four Corners Senora Stakes (R) for state-bred fillies and mares at SunRay Park. On November 27, the mare ran fourth, two lengths behind winner Blazin N Shakin, in the 400-yard, \$150,460 New Mexico Fillies & Mares Championship (RG2) at Zia Park.

My Box Of Chocolate, Rime Has A Chick, Ms Regard, BP Shes Southern, Woody Dungarees, and Blushing Daisy completed the order of finish.

Lethal Delight is a homebred 4-year-old mare by champion Dean Miracle who was coming off of a second-place finish in the New Mexico Fillies & Mares Championship. Campaigned by P.K. Thomas, Lethal Delight has won eight of 18 races and has earned \$425,663, and her stakes record includes a victory in the 400-yard, \$334,257 Shue Fly Stakes (RG1) at Sunland Park in '09.

Blazin N Shakin banked \$12,000 to push her bankroll to \$635,335 for her owner and breeder, Mike Abraham of Las Vegas, Nevada. The 5-year-old gray daughter of Chicks A Blazin has won 10 of 16 races, and her seven career stakes scores include the 2009 Lou Wooten Handicap.

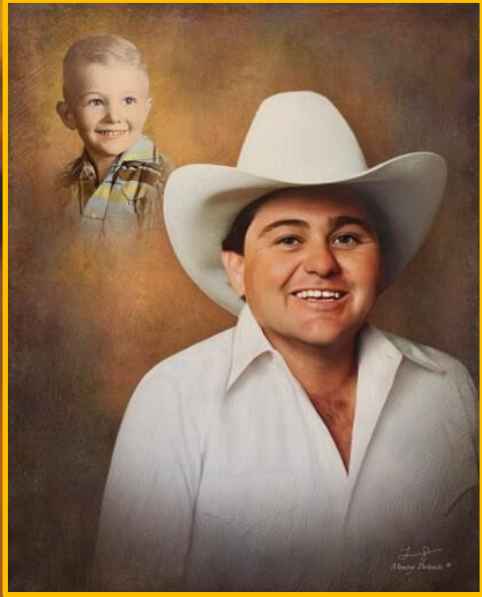

You don't have to wait for your AQHA or Jockey Club papers to submit a New Mexico Bred application for your foals! All foals **MUST BE** conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status.

Remember the horse is NOT an official New Mexico Bred & CANNOT run in a NM Bred race until the certificates have been finalized by our office.

AQHA papers must be stamped in our office. Jockey Club papers are "stamped" online.

OWNERS

Due to a NM State statute, all owners running a New Mexico Bred on the track must become a 2023 member of NMHBA within 90 days of placing 1st, 2nd, or 3rd if not a 2023 member already!!

All memberships expire December 31 each year.

If you do not comply you will forfeit your 2023 Award Distribution checks in November!!

Tell your friends and continue to pass the word along!

The cut-off for award checks this year is the end of State Fair (September 24, 2023), so any races run after State Fair will be on NEXT year's checks!

Request for Broodmares in Foal to
Leave the State of New Mexico for Sale

All foals **MUST BE** conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status.

If a registered NM Broodmare in foal to a registered NM Stallion leaves the state of New Mexico:

- The application and the \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the breeding year. If the application and \$500 fee are **NOT** received by the applicable deadline, there is a ten day grace period and then the fee increases to \$1,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.
- Every donor mare and every recipient mare that is taken to board out of state must have their own form filled out and you must pay \$500.00 for each or the larger \$1,000 penalty if the October 1 deadline is missed.

EXPORT BROODMARE RETURN FORMS BEGINNING WITH 2022 FOALS ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED!

You must still fill out the Export Form and pay \$500 per mare by October 1!

STALLION EVA REQUIREMENTS

EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW STALLIONS

All stallions MUST have a negative EVA test and be vaccinated for EVA within 10 days of the COLLECTION date according to the rules of the New Mexico Livestock Board before you can register them in the NM Permanent Stallion Registry.

EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR STALLIONS IN OUR REGISTRY

All NM registered stallions must have an annual EVA booster vaccination.

Per NM Livestock Board regulations, they must be quarantined for 28 days after receiving the booster because it is a live virus and can be passed to other horses. The deadline to turn in the EVA Booster Certificate to our office was February 1, 2023. Please call our office ASAP if you have not returned your booster form yet.
