Dear Members:

The Trustees of the New Mexico Horse Breeders have met to discuss the new By-Law change that allows any reproductive procedure to be done outside of the state of New Mexico if it is not readily available within New Mexico. It has come to our attention that on occasion embryo transfer procedures are not always readily available in New Mexico and you may have to have embryo transfers done out of state.

We are requesting that if you have already or have plans to take a pregnant mare or her embryo out of New Mexico and have an embryo transfer done, that you notify the association office by filling out the questionnaire form that follows this letter and return it to us either by email or the U.S. mail as soon as possible.

Remember that other than ICSI, the breeding must take place in New Mexico and all foals must be born in New Mexico. If an embryo transfer procedure is done out of state, any donor or recipient mare that spends any time physically out of the state of New Mexico must be enrolled in the Export Broodmare Program. There is a \$500.00 fee for each mare and there is a form that needs to be completed and submitted by October 1st. That form also follows this letter.

Whenever there is an embryo transfer done for a New Mexico Bred foal, we require that the veterinarian that performs the procedure completes the embryo transfer report. If we receive a foal application for a New Mexico Bred embryo transfer foal and we do not have the embryo transfer report, the veterinarian will have to submit the report or a notarized affidavit before the foal registration will be completed. This form also follows this letter.

Remember that all donor mares and recipient mares need to be put into our broodmare registry in order for their foals to be eligible to be registered as New Mexico Breds. The deadline to register new broodmares is September 1st of the year of breeding. Once a mare is put into the registry, she is in for life.

For your convenience, we have included a list of farms and veterinarians that have been known to perform embryo transfers or to flush and ship embryos in the state of New Mexico.



Aided by a reported 20-mph tail wind, Over Da Edge stopped the timer in :17.229 while recording a 101 speed index and defeating Miss Baby Cartel by a neck. Sergio Becerra Jr. rode the filly for trainer Eric Valenzuela.



Ten New Mexican Spring Futurity Trials Set for Saturday at Sunland Park

"Recent winner HS Danger Weapon is one of 94 state-bred 2-year-old Quarter Horses entered in Saturday's 300yard New Mexican Spring Futurity (RG2) trials at Sunland Park.

A homebred son of Osbaldo racing for Hubaldo Solis of Peralta, New Mexico, HS Danger Weapon made his debut with a three-quarter length victory in a 300-yard, \$30,000 maiden-special-weight dash for New Mexicobred juveniles on March 2. Armando Alamos trains the gray colt.



Retired Fusaichi Zenon Returns to California

Feb 23, 2024 Posted By CTBA In Announcement

SOLVANG, Calif. (Feb. 23, 2024) — Japanese-bred Fusaichi Zenon will be calling Kingfisher Farms home. The \$768,157-earner was found in an auction pen in Texas on February 21, and a massive effort was rallied to bring him out safely.

A son of Sunday Silence, Fusaichi Zenon broke his maiden first out in Japan at Hanshin. He won a pair of stakes races – including a Grade 2 event – early in 2000 and arrived in California in 2001. Second in an allowance race at Del Mar, Fusaichi Zenon shipped to Belmont Park to run fourth in the Grade 1 Man o' War Stakes before retirement.

Retired with a record of three wins and a second in eight starts, Fusaichi Zenon originally went to stud at Magali Farms near Santa Ynez. He completed his stallion career in New Mexico.

An inspiring social media effort was made to generate the funds to secure and transport this classy horse to his new home. He will live out his days peacefully thanks to KERRI – Kingfisher Equine Rescue and Rehabilitation, Inc – a non-profit 501c3 organization dedicated to retired racehorses. It was founded by Kingfisher Farms' Katie Fisher, and aims to provide the highest standard of sustainable racehorse aftercare.



DO YOU REMEMBER... SIXES ROYAL is the sire of SIXY CHAMISA Multiple Graded Stakes Winner of \$380,095



Sent to post at odds of 9-10, Sixy Chamisa led at every call en route to a 1 ¼-length victory in the April 17 Sunburst Stakes (R) for New Mexico-bred 3-year-old fillies at Sunland Park.

Sixy Chamisa races for SM Cattle Export Co. of Socorro, Texas, and the Sixes Royal filly covered 350 yards in :17.030 while scoring her second stakes win. Freddie Martinez rode Sixy Chamisa for trainer Roberto Sanchez.

Sixy Chamisa was bred by Mike Abraham, and the filly is one of two stakes winners from three crops sired by Sixes Royal, a 9-year-old son of champion Royal Quick Dash who won the 2004 Texas Classic Derby (G1) at Lone Star Park and was a finalist in three Grade 1 futurities in '03, including the All American Futurity. A half brother to 870-yard Grade 3 stakes winner Four Six Dash, Sixes Royal has sired the earners of more than \$1.5 million from 117 starters. He stands for a \$2,000 fee at W.L. Mooring's Double L Farm at Bosque, New Mexico.

Sixy Chamisa is also one of five winners from six starters foaled by the winning Chicks A Blazin mare Chicks Chamisa. The filly is a half sister to Me Chickie, a filly by Major Rime who won last year's \$47,000 Lineage Championship (RG2) at The Downs at Albuquerque and was last season's New Mexico region high-point aged mare, and Rime Has A Chick, a daughter of Major Rime who won two New Mexico-bred stakes in '08, the Pelican Stakes (RG3) and Manuel Lujan Handicap (RG3) at Albuquerque.

Sixy Chamisa's second dam, the Sparkling Moolah mare Sparkling Parade, produced 1995 Santa Fe Downs

Derby (RG3) winner Nathans Rocket and '95 New Mexico State Fair Senorita Futurity (RG3) winner Moolahs Crown, both of whom are half siblings to Chicks Chamisa. The filly's second dam, Cannonade Parade, was an unraced daughter of the Three Oh's stallion Sinn Fein who foaled stakes winners Macy Day Parade and Parade The Moolah.

All told, Sixy Chamisa has earned \$216,413 from seven wins in 10 outs, and the filly's stakes resume includes a victory in last year's \$150,000 New Mexico Breeders' Futurity (RG2) at SunRay Park. She also ran second in the New Mexico Cup Futurity (RG1) at Zia Park, and she was a finalist in the January 2 Shue Fly Stakes (RG1) at Sunland Park and last year's Zia Futurity (RG1) at Ruidoso Downs.

Six Royal Alibis ran second and was followed by Art To Mayor, 7-2 second choice Niftys Royal Flush, Me Bankita, Auntie G, Invisible Love, Candia Misty, Lucky Ladyaces, and Champagne Fame.

A sorrel filly by Sixes Royal racing for Deanna Cavender, Six Royal Alibis earned \$15,750 to push her bankroll to \$42,757. Six Royal Alibis was coming off of a neck victory in a 400-yard allowance race on March 2, her first start after being claimed by her connections for \$12,500 on January 16.

Art To Mayor banked \$7,500 to boost her earnings to \$34,221 for her owner Hermenegildo "Poppy" Aldavaz, a resident of Chamberino, New Mexico, who also bred and trains the bay Major Rime filly. Art To Mayor won a pair of 330-yard claiming sprints last fall at Zia Park.



You don't have to wait for your AQHA or Jockey Club papers to submit a New Mexico Bred application for your foals! All foals MUST BE conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status.

Remember the horse is NOT an official New Mexico Bred & CANNOT run in a NM Bred race until the certificates have been finalized by our office.

AQHA papers must be stamped in our office. Jockey Club papers are "stamped" online.

OWNERS

Due to a NM State statute, all owners running a New Mexico Bred on the track must become a 2024 member of NMHBA within 90 days of placing 1st, 2nd, or 3rd if not a 2024 member already!!

All memberships expire December 31 each year.

If you do not comply you will forfeit your 2024 Award Distribution checks in November!!

EXPORT BROODMARE FORMS



Export Broodmare Form

Request for Broodmares in Foal to Leave the State of New Mexico for Sale All foals MUST BE conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status. If a registered NM Broodmare in foal to a registered NM Stallion leaves the state of New Mexico:

- The application and the \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the breeding year. If the application and \$500 fee are NOT received by the applicable deadline, there is a ten day grace period and then the fee increases to \$1,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.
- Every donor mare and every recipient mare that is taken to board out of state must have their own form filled out and you must pay \$500.00 for each or the larger \$1,000 penalty if the October 1 deadline is missed.

EXCEPTION (Bylaw change January 25, 2024):

 1. All assisted reproduction techniques including but not limited to the transfer of embryos or oocytes must be performed within the State of New Mexico unless the service is not readily available in the state. OOCYTES may be done in other states if the out-of-state ICSI requirements are followed. The mare would be required to be enrolled in the Export Broodmare Program by October 1st of the year she was taken out of New Mexico.

EXPORT BROODMARE RETURN FORMS BEGINNING WITH 2022 FOALS ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED!

You must still fill out the Export Form and pay \$500 per mare by October 1!

STALLION EVA REQUIREMENTS

EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW STALLIONS

All stallions MUST have a negative EVA test and be vaccinated for EVA within 10 days of the COLLECTION date according to the rules of the New Mexico Livestock Board before you can register them in the NM Permanent Stallion Registry.

EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR STALLIONS IN OUR REGISTRY

All NM registered stallions must have an annual EVA booster vaccination.

Per NM Livestock Board regulations, they must be quarantined for 28 days after receiving the booster because it is a live virus and can be passed to other horses. The deadline to turn in the EVA Booster Certificate to our office was February 1, 2023. Please call our office ASAP if you have not returned your booster form yet.
