# \$12 MILLION DUBAI WORLD CUP



Senor Buscador ran 3<sup>rd</sup>  
in the  
\$12 Million  
Dubai World Cup!

**“Senor Buscador, a Kentucky-bred son of Mineshaft with strong New Mexico roots, ran third in the March 30, \$12-million Dubai World Cup (G1) at Meydan Racecourse.**

**Trained by Todd Fincher for owners Joe R. Peacock Jr. and Sharaf Mohammed S. Al Hariri, Senor Buscador finished behind winner Laurel River and runner-up Ushba Tesoro in the 1 1/4 mile race. The bay stallion was coming off a victory in the world’s richest horse race, the February 4, \$20-million Saudi Cup (G1) at King Abdulaziz Racecourse.**

**“We’re very proud of him and a little disappointed that he didn’t get second,” said Fincher of Senor Buscador’s Dubai World Cup performance. “He definitely wasn’t going to beat Laurel River...”**

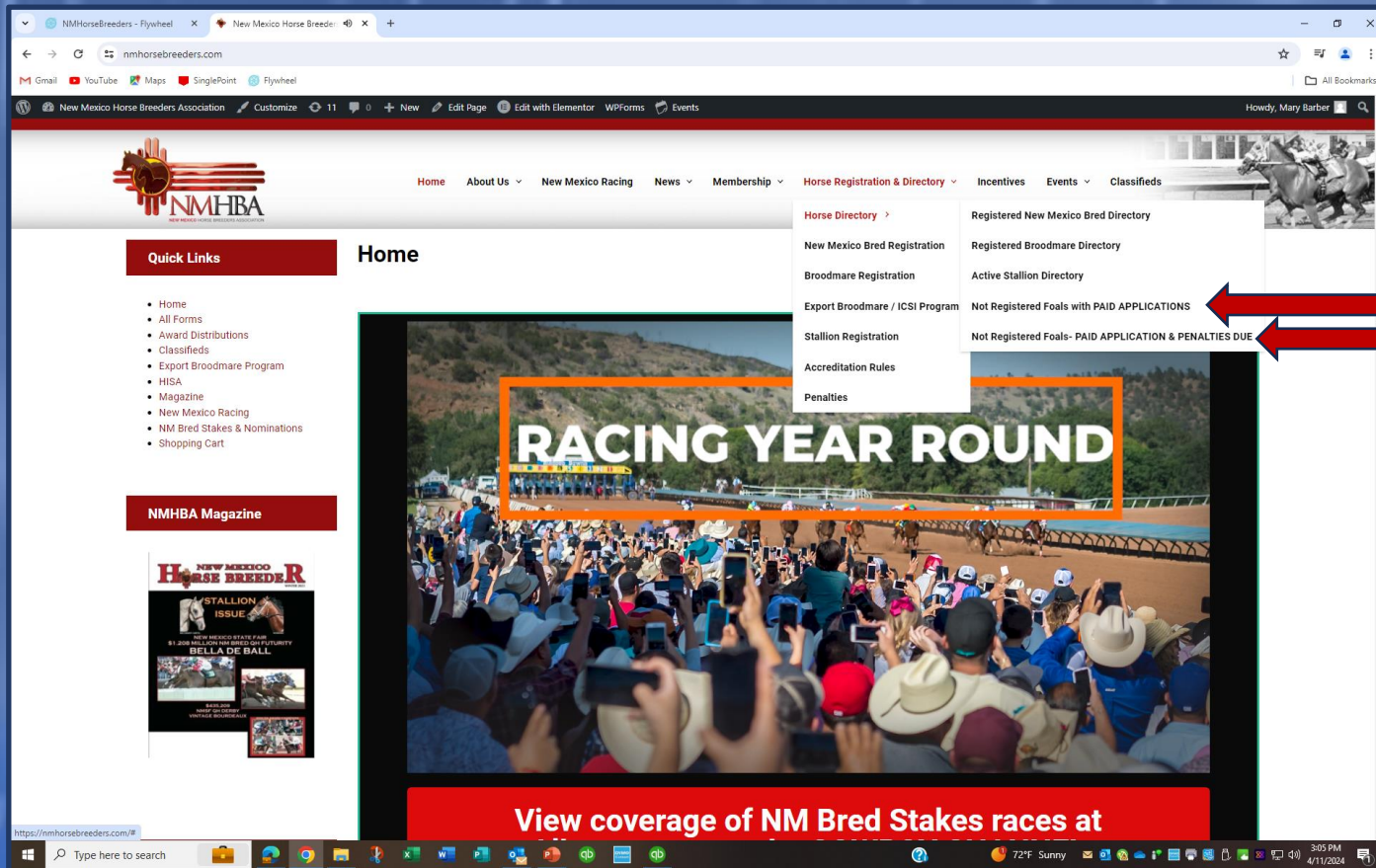

# SUNLAND PARK RECAP



“Sunland Park Racetrack ended its 55-day Thoroughbred and Quarter Horse season on Sunday, April 7.

Dick Cappellucci led all Thoroughbred trainers with 30 wins from 116 starters, three more than runner-up Todd Fincher, who saddled the winners of 27 races from 94 starters. However, Fincher led all Thoroughbred trainers in starter earnings at \$1,429,914.

Alfredo Juarez Jr. was Sunland Park’s leading Thoroughbred jockey with 34 wins from 150 mounts, three more than runner-up Alejandro Medellin, who won 31 races from 174 mounts. Christian Ramos was the meet’s leading Thoroughbred rider in mount earnings at \$882,384

Alfred Alvarado topped all Sunland Park Thoroughbred owners with 11 wins from 36 starters, three more than runner-up Dick Cappellucci, who won eight races from 24 starters. J. Kirk and Judy Robison of El Paso, Texas, led all Thoroughbred owners in purse earnings at \$558,782.

On the Quarter Horse side, Wes Giles was Sunland Park’s leading trainer with 18 wins from 87 starters, five more than runner-up Eric Valenzuela, who prepped the winners of 13 races from 72 starters. Valenzuela was the track’s leading Quarter Horse trainer in starter earnings at \$539,051...”

“SunRay Park near Farmington, New Mexico, will open its 18-day spring Thoroughbred and Quarter Horse meet with a 12-race program on Friday, April 12. Post time for the first race is set for 1:15 p.m. (MDT).

Friday’s opening-day program is anchored by the 400-yard, \$70,000 New Mexico Breeders’ Stakes (RG3), which has drawn an overflow field of 12 state-bred 3-year-old Quarter Horses. The New Mexico Breeders’ Stakes is one of 10 stakes -- five for Thoroughbreds and five for Quarter Horses -- on the SunRay Park stakes schedule, which will pay out an estimated \$1 million in purse money...”

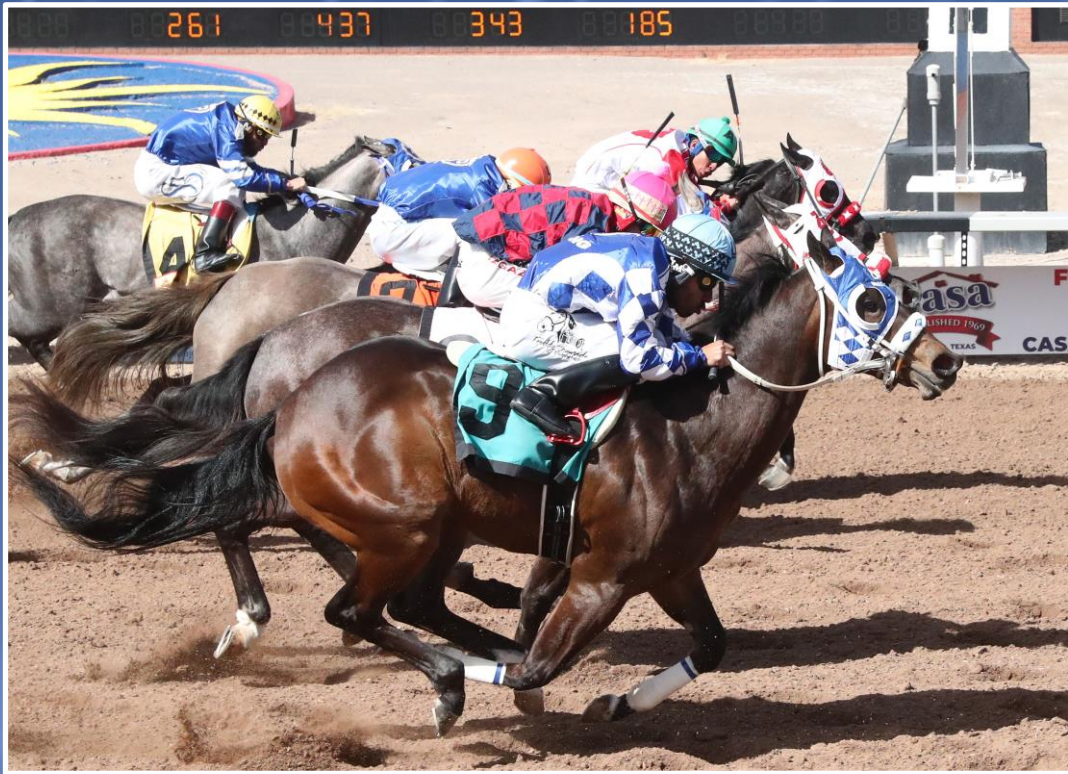

## 1981-82 sunland park wrapup



The daily wagering average for the 1981-82 season at Sunland Park ended up at \$349,182, a gain of 21.48 percent over the previous season. The current meeting covered 84 race days and 968 races. Total wagering for the 81-82 season was \$29,331,282. That figure, plus the \$349,182 average, were the highest in Sunland's 23 year history. The current meet attracted 258,184 patrons, an average of 3,074 per day, up 5.74 percent from the previous year. Fans wagered an average of \$30,301 per race as compared to last season's record \$24,907, a gain of 21.66 per cent. A new record was set on closing day as \$603,335 was wagered compared to last year's mark of \$539,055. The 1982 Riley Allison Futurity triggered the largest one race handle ever recorded at Sunland — \$76,233.

Twist Her, a Navajo filly, was named the spring season's best two year old Thoroughbred and best two year old filly after winning the Riley Allison Futurity, the richest race ever run at Sunland. She earned \$159,095 for her one length win in the five furlong Allison, with a gross purse of \$331,404.

Two happy New Mexico owners, Jake Box and Ray Starbuck of Clovis entered the winner's circle to receive the trophy for the West Texas Futurity, won by Sail On Bunny, a son of Bunny Bid and trained by veteran Jake Cascio. The colt collected \$74,784 out of a gross purse of \$221,575. Sail On Bunny, still showing his championship form, recently won the Kindergarten Stakes, the first leg of the West Coast's triple crown for two year olds, at Los Alamos.

The best New Mexico Thoroughbred was Saurkraut, a six year old Bold Dunes gelding. He netted one win, two seconds and one third in seven outings against the finest competition in the area. He dropped a nose decision to Aminaum in the fastest 6 furlong race this season. Trained by Elmer Shepard, Saurkraut is owned by Jess Burner of Anthony. Easter Wrangler was named the best New Mexico bred Quarter Horse. A four year old Rocket Wrangler gelding, he won three races against stiff allowance competition. Easter Wrangler is trained by M. Dooley Guinn and owned by Gwendolyn Eaves of Hobbs.

The wagering public compiled a remarkable batting average during the 1981-82 season. Of the 968 races run

Native Gypsy, who has compiled one of the most remarkable winning streaks in New Mexico horse racing, was named Sunland Park's spring horse-of-the-meet. The five year old Special Secret mare won four straight races over the 55 day spring campaign. Besides being named horse-of-the-meet, Native Gypsy was also named best older Quarter Horse and best handicap Quarter Horse.

Glo Billy Sims, who tallied a one length victory in the \$303,832 Sun Country Futurity on April 25th, earned the best two year old colt or gelding and best two year old Quarter Horse. The Little Glo colt set the fastest qualifying time for the Sun Country, the third richest race ever run at Sunland Park. His 17.31 time trial reading earned him a superb 111 speed index. Glo Billy Sims was recently leased by the Urschels of Canadian, Texas.

341 were won by favorites, for an average of 35.23 percent, well above the national average. For the horses, the No. 2 slot was the best of the season, producing 120 winners. Surprisingly, the No. 8 was among the better posts, producing 106 winners. The claiming box was also kept busy at Sunland Park as total transactions from 250 head brought \$903,950 for an average price of \$3,615.

Sherry's Rebel, owned by John Augustine of Las Cruces, NM, closed with eager strides to win the first running of the Shue Fly Stakes at Sunland Park.

The speedy gelding got off to a slow start in the muddy 400-yard run, then found his best stride at the midway point and came on strong to take the crown. The Shue Fly Stakes is conditioned exclusively for New Mexico-breds.

The head victory by Sherry's Rebel, who had seasoned jockey Richard Bickel aboard, was good for a paycheck of \$7,995 from the gross pot of \$15,990.

Rebel Cider, a 76-1 shot piloted by Luis Jiminez for Grant Brumlow of Las Cruces, set the pace before having to settle for second.

Cormick String, a 7-2 pick directed by veteran Jack Wallace for Jerry and C. C. Henson of Denver City, Texas, flashed good early speed but was unable to keep up with the two leaders and finished third.

The winning time on the off track was 20.01, an improvement over the top qualifying time of 20.20 which was shared by Sherry's Rebel and H. J. Lee's Best Baby.

The Shue Fly victory brought the winnings of Sherry's Rebel to nearly \$40,000.

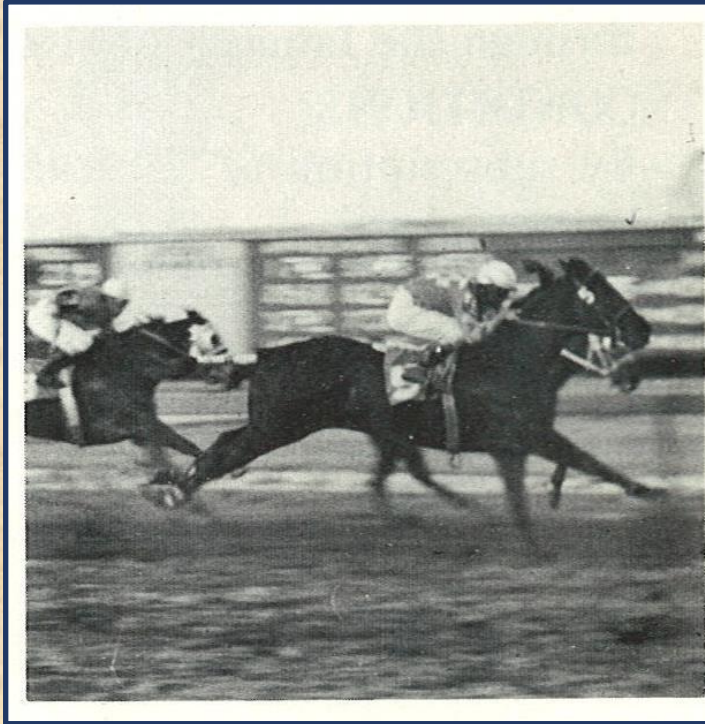
"Sherry's Rebel was a little unsettled in the gate," Bickel said after the victory, "but after we got going, he took to the track right away. The muddy condition didn't bother him at all. Most of the credit for the win has to go to trainer Buffalo Wooten for keeping this horse in such top shape."

The race was practically a rebellion, from a breeding standpoint. Sherry's Rebel is by

Bright Rebel out of Bright Sherry; Rebel Cider is by Bright Rebel out of Cider Louise; and Dee Bar Bright, who finished fifth, is by Bright Rebel out of Bright Bardee.

The also-rans in the tough field of qualifying freshmen were, in order, Best Baby, Dee Bar Bright, San Storm, Board Ship Jr., Tollie Bogel, Mo Bright Fox and Mr. Swinger.

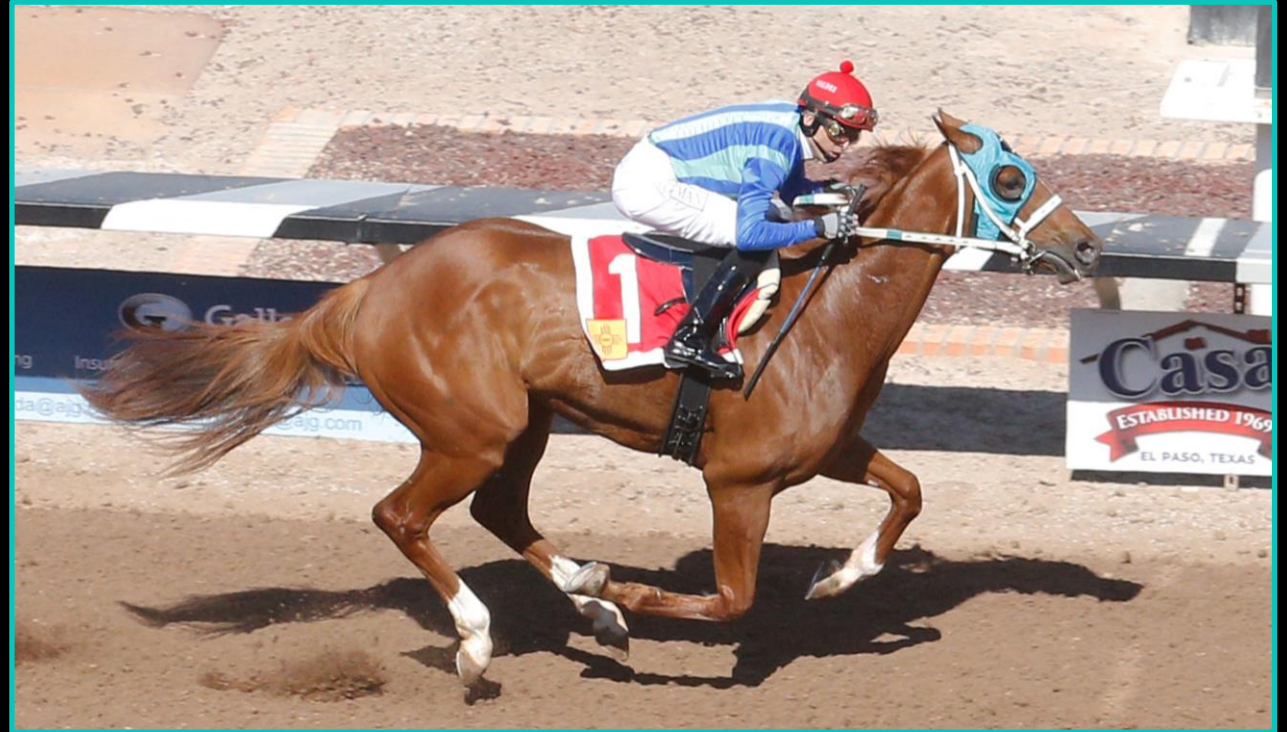

# EXPORT BROODMARE FORMS



## Export Broodmare Form

Request for Broodmares in Foal to  
Leave the State of New Mexico for Sale

All foals **MUST BE** conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status. If a registered NM Broodmare in foal to a registered NM Stallion leaves the state of New Mexico:

- The application and the \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the breeding year. If the application and \$500 fee are NOT received by the applicable deadline, there is a ten day grace period and then the fee increases to \$1,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.
- Every donor mare and every recipient mare that is taken to board out of state must have their own form filled out and you must pay \$500.00 for each or the larger \$1,000 penalty if the October 1 deadline is missed.

### EXCEPTION (Bylaw change January 25, 2024):

- 1. All assisted reproduction techniques including but not limited to the transfer of embryos or oocytes must be performed within the State of New Mexico unless the service is not readily available in the state. OOCYTES may be done in other states if the out-of-state ICSI requirements are followed. The mare would be required to be enrolled in the Export Broodmare Program by October 1st of the year she was taken out of New Mexico.

You must still fill out the Export Form and pay \$500 per mare by October 1!



# STALLION EVA REQUIREMENTS

## EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW STALLIONS

All stallions MUST have a negative EVA test and be vaccinated for EVA within 10 days of the COLLECTION date according to the rules of the New Mexico Livestock Board before you can register them in the NM Permanent Stallion Registry.

## EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR STALLIONS IN OUR REGISTRY

All NM registered stallions must have an annual EVA booster vaccination.

Per NM Livestock Board regulations, they must be quarantined for 28 days after receiving the booster because it is a live virus and can be passed to other horses. The deadline to turn in the EVA Booster Certificate to our office was February 1, 2023. Please call our office ASAP if you have not returned your booster form yet.
