





"Making the second start of her 3-year-old season, Uno Menos' Miss Hi Tide sprinted to a one-length win in the June 15, 350-yard Mountain Top Derby (R) for New Mexico-bred sophomore Quarter Horses.

Miss Hi Tide stopped the timer in :17.667 under jockey Adrian Ramos. Wes Giles trained the sorrel Woodbridge filly, who was earning her first career stakes victory.

Miss Hi Tide was the sixth-fastest qualifier from six trials run on June 1. The filly was bred by Mac and Janis Murray's MJ Farms at Veguita, New Mexico..."

Harken, a gelded son of Eye Am King and the seventh-fastest qualifier, held on at the wire to win the June 16, \$351,484 Mountain Top Futurity (RG2) for New Mexico-bred 2-year-old Quarter Horses at Ruidoso Downs. Prepped by Marco Flores for owner Ernesto Soto, Harken covered 350 yards in :17.765, and his margin of victory was a nose from fifth-fastest qualifier Eye Im Flashin, who was clocked in :17.770. Sergio Becerra Jr. rode the sorrel gelding.

"I was peeking over to my left, and I thought we had them," said Becerra, who has ridden Harken in all of the gelding's races, including his trial. "I'm fortunate to have some experience with this horse. I knew he was capable of the win."

Racing against a reported 12-mph head wind and sent to post at odds of 5-1 in the field of nine, Woody Rocks covered 350 yards in :17.979, and his margin of victory was a neck from 5-2 favorite Macho Daddys Girl. Luis Martinez rode the sorrel Woodbridge gelding for trainer Tony Sedillo.

## New Mexico-Breds Fare Well At The Fair

#### I CUT AN ACE CAPTURES \$68,117 GEORGE MALOOF FUTURITY

I Cut An Ace held all the winning cards in the \$68,117 George Maloof Futurity.

The brown gelding was just off the early pace while saving all the ground along the rail in the six furlong Maloof. As the horses passed the half mile pole, jockey J.P. Maxwell sent the state-bred to the front and held off the stubborn charge of longshot Cat Can to get the win by a head.

Favored Sweetfella was forced wide on the turn for home but had no excuse in the stretch and had to settle for third with Town Trickster fourth in the field of 10 New Mexico bred 2 year olds.

AQHA papers must be stamped in our office. Jockey Club papers are "stamped" online.

## **OWNERS**

Due to a NM State statute, all owners running a New Mexico Bred on the track must become a 2024 member of NMHBA within 90 days of placing 1st, 2nd, or 3rd if not a 2024 member already!!

All memberships expire December 31 each year.

If you do not comply you will forfeit your 2024 Award Distribution checks in November!!

## **EXPORT BROODMARE FORMS**



#### **Export Broodmare Form**

Out of State Embryo Transfer Questionaire

2024 Embryo Transfer &/or ICSI Report for Veterinarian All foals MUST BE conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status. If a registered NM Broodmare in foal to a registered NM Stallion leaves the state of New Mexico:

- The application and the \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the breeding year. If the application and \$500 fee are NOT received by the applicable deadline, there is a ten day grace period and then the fee increases to \$1,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.
- Every donor mare and every recipient mare that is taken to board out of state must have their own form filled out and you must pay \$500.00 for each or the larger \$1,000 penalty if the October 1 deadline is missed.

#### EXCEPTION (Bylaw change January 25, 2024):

 All assisted reproduction techniques including but not limited to the transfer of embryos or oocytes must be performed within the State of New Mexico unless the service is not readily available in the state. OOCYTES may be done in other states if the out-of-state ICSI requirements are followed. The mare would be required to be enrolled in the Export Broodmare Program by October 1st of the year she was taken out of New Mexico.

EXPORT BROODMARE RETURN FORMS BEGINNING WITH 2022 FOALS ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED! You must still fill out the Export Form and pay \$500 per mare by October 1!

## **STALLION EVA REQUIREMENTS**

All stallions MUST have a negative EVA test and be vaccinated for EVA within 10 days of the COLLECTION date according to the rules of the New Mexico Livestock Board before you can register them in the NM Permanent Stallion Registry.

#### EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR STALLIONS IN OUR REGISTRY

All NM registered stallions must have an annual EVA booster vaccination.

Per NM Livestock Board regulations, they must be quarantined for 28 days after receiving the booster because it is a live virus and can be passed to other horses. The deadline to turn in the EVA Booster Certificate to our office was February 1, 2023. Please call our office ASAP if you have not returned your booster form yet.
