(Ruidoso Downs, NM) After a review of accessible horse stalls in Albuquerque, All American Horse Sales LLC has announced that the New Mexico-bred and All American Select Sale will return to the regular venue at Ruidoso Downs Race Track.

“After further investigation of the Albuquerque facilities we discovered we were some 150 stalls short of what we need to conduct those sales,” said Walt Wiggins, general manager of the sales.

“We apologize for any inconvenience that has been caused for all concerned, and we look forward to seeing everyone in the cool pines of Ruidoso.”

The dates for the New Mexico-bred sale will be August 16-17 starting at 5 p.m. (MDT) each day. There are 229 consignments scheduled to be sold.

The All American Select Sale will be held August 30-31 beginning at 4 p.m. (MDT) each day. A total of 425 consignments are scheduled to be sold.

Dear Members,

The New Mexico Horse Breeders Board of Trustees would like to be able to set the date and location of the annual meetings and this would take a By-Law change. All By-Law changes must be voted on by the membership.

Currently, the By-Laws, under Article IV – Meetings of Members, we are required to hold the annual meeting in January and the exact date and place of the meeting the following year is voted upon by the members present at the current annual meeting.

At one time, the Downs At Albuquerque ran their live meet in January and this worked well since a lot of our members were in Albuquerque and could come to the meeting. Now there is no racing going on in Albuquerque in January and this also falls during foaling and breeding season. The Trustees would like to be able to change this so that the meeting will be held at a better time of year and where more people would be available to attend. They would also prefer to hold the meeting in conjunction with the awards ceremony if possible.

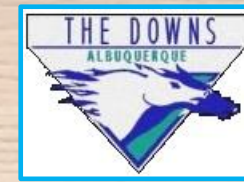

“Three New Mexico-bred Quarter Horses qualified to three of American Quarter Horse racing’s most prestigious races, which will be run during Labor Day weekend, September 1-2, at Albuquerque Downs.

KJ Bad Moon Rising (pictured), a homebred son of the Apollitical Jess stallion KJ Mucho Macho Man racing for John Lee and Kathy Lee, recorded the ninth-fastest qualifying time to the sport’s richest and most prestigious race, the

440-yard, \$3-million All American Futurity (G1) on Monday, September 2. Christian Ramos rode the bay New Mexico-bred gelding for trainer Wes Giles...

Bigg Picture, a New Mexico-bred Big Daddy Cartel gelding trained by Wes Giles for owner Uno Menos, set the 10th-fastest qualifying time to Quarter Horse racing’s richest race for 3-year-olds, the September 2, \$1,076,535 All American Derby (G1). Ridden by Adrian Ramos, Bigg Picture ran third in one of eight 440-yard trials on August 11...

Also on August 11, Uno Menos’ Miss Hi Tide qualified to the September 2, \$626,135 All American Oaks (G1) for 3-year-old fillies. Ridden by Adrian Ramos for trainer Wes Giles, the New Mexico-bred daughter of the Dash Ta Fame stallion Woodbridge ran third in her 440-yard trial while setting the ninth-fastest qualifying time...”

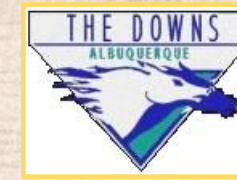

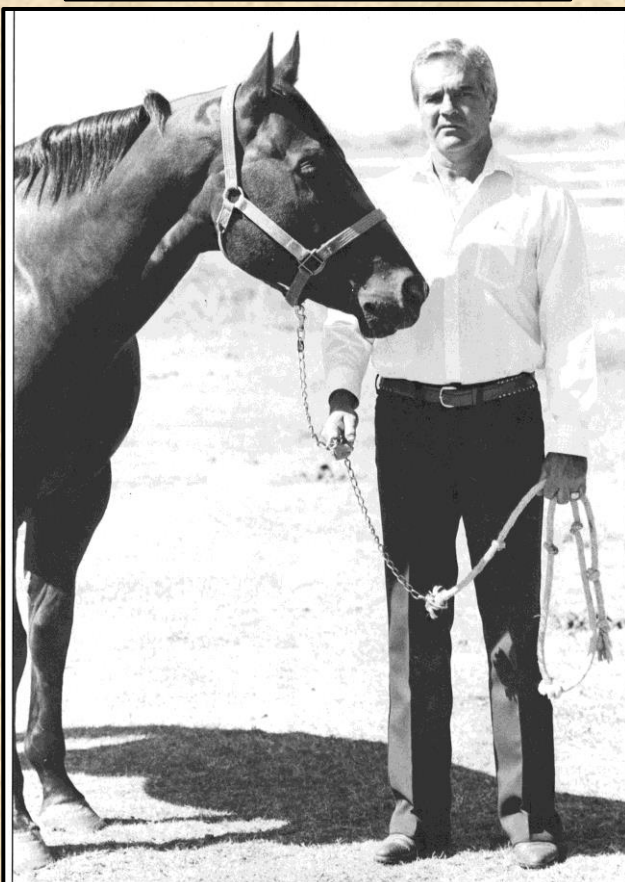

FRED TIDWELL

The Sweet Taste of a Win

WINNING IS RARE IN THE HORSE BUSINESS, BUT IT KEEPS FRED TIDWELL COMING BACK.

The thrill of riding a fast race horse, once experienced, is never forgotten. The wind whistles past your ears, but you can still hear the hoofbeats and your own heart. The living machine beneath you surges faster, and you become a part of it. If you win, a sweet taste appears in your mouth — a flavor obtainable no other way. It doesn't matter if it's a country matched race, a brush track race or the big time. That taste is always the same, and is extremely addictive — it gets in your blood.

In 1956, Fred married, and a couple of years later he went to work for his father-in-law, who had a plumbing business in Alamogordo. He and his wife built a beautiful home just north of town, and they had three sons: Todd, Tab and Thad. Fred lost his wife in an accident in 1972, when Thad was two years old. He never remarried, and raised his sons alone.

"They're all grown, now," he said. "The youngest is 18. All of them work with me." The family's businesses are: Tidwell Mobile Home Sales; Tidwell

Plumbing, Heating and Cooling; a subdivision development in Alamogordo; and Tidwell's 3 T Farm (the race horse business). The 3 T's are from the three sons' first initials. The race horse business spilled over slightly into the subdivision development — some of the streets are named for their best race horses.

As Fred worked building his businesses, he never quite left the running horses, although he didn't become a breeder until about ten years ago.

In the early 1970s he claimed some

when they were only 12 or 13 years old. In the late 1940s and early 1950s, matched races were held almost every weekend. Fred and Dan rode in those, too.

"We rode horses my Dad raised and outside horses," he said. "I've fooled with race horses all my life."

Besides the horses, Fred's parents raised nine children on their ranch at Pinon, in the Sacramento Mountains southeast of Alamogordo. "We went to school in Pinon and Weed," Fred said.

Fred's father has died, but his mother, now 80 years old, lives in Artesia.

horses. The first one was Otro Sol. "I claimed him for \$1,500 at Ruidoso, took him to the State Fair and won a race with him, but somebody else claimed him," Fred remembered. "At one time we had seven or eight different-priced claiming horses."

There is another victory taste, different but just as addictive, that comes when you watch a horse you own streak across the finish line in front. And if it's one you raised yourself, it's doubly sweet. Incredible T. gave Fred that special feeling.

"We had bought

some mares in California," he said, "and some at the Ruidoso Thoroughbred sale. We had a lot of bad luck with them. Most of

them died, or they had accidents."

There's an old horseman's maxim: If it's a good one, it'll get hurt. Fred must have had some mighty good horses, because his run of bad luck seemed as if it would never end.

One example: "I'd bought a good yearling filly by the name of Constant," he said. "She ran second in the Riley Allison Futurity. But as a 3-year-old, it seemed something was always wrong with her, and she finally broke her leg in an allowance race at the State Fair. "We put her leg in a cast and I babied her," Fred said. "Then I bred her to a son of Northern Dancer, Highland Drummer. We got her in foal, and then she got colic and died."

Most people would have quit. Fred came close, but not quite. "I ended up selling everything except this one mare we had raised out of one of those California mares."

He took that mare, Smugglin T., to the Hondo Ranch and bred her to Lil King. "We got Incredible T.," he said with that winner's smile. "He was growing and looking good, so I finally started galloping him. Then I sent him to James Havens at Ruidoso, and he won his first maiden race pretty easy. That built our hopes up."

He got boxed in on the turn in the New Mexico Futurity at Ruidoso, but they knew he could run, so they took him to the State Fair. He got sick.

James Havens wasn't going to Sunland Park, so Fred took Incredible T. to Don Farris there. "He won three or four races in a row," Fred said. As a 3-year-old, Incredible T. won the Jemez Handicap at Santa Fe, the 6-furlong Roadrunner Handicap at Ruidoso, the 1 1/16-mile New Mexico Derby at the State Fair, the Cutarusty Handicap at Sunland

Park. In fact, Incredible T. lacked less than a hundred dollars winning enough to be the 1983 New Mexico Bred 3-year-old of the year.

"The further you went, the better he liked it," Fred recalled. "He always came from behind to win." Fred sold the horse the next year, but he had savored that special owner-breeder victory taste.

In 1983 he bought Sure Casady at the All-American Sale. The black Quarter Horse stallion is by Casady Casanova and out of a Jet Deck mare. Sure Casady had an excellent racing career, and came within a whisker of beating the best ones in the nation at Ruidoso Downs. He earned an impressive 98 SI there.

Now Fred has him standing at stud on the home Alamogordo farm. "We'd like to have some good mares, either Quarter Horse or Thoroughbred, come to him," Fred said. "There should be

speed and quickness in the babies."

There has been another bit of bad luck. Fred bought a \$10,000 mare named Razor Blade and bred her to Sure Casady in 1985. "She got kicked in the leg, got blood poisoning and died," he said.

However, he also bred a mare named Miss Tyrant T. (whom he bought in Kentucky as a yearling) to Sure Casady, and she had a fine-looking colt — Im Casady. The colt is a growthy, well-made yearling now, and Fred is cautiously hopeful. He has the colt nominated for the All-American Futurity.

Incredible T.'s mother, Smugglin T., has not yet had another winner. This year, the vet and everybody else agreed she was in foal to Sure Casady, but she apparently absorbed the baby. Undaunted, Fred said, "I plan to breed her to Sure Casady this spring."

Fred Tidwell definitely intends to stay in the running horse business. He's had more than his share of bad luck, but he's also tasted the sweetness of victory, and that taste makes up for all the bad luck. The winner's circle will be home to other Tidwell-bred race horses.

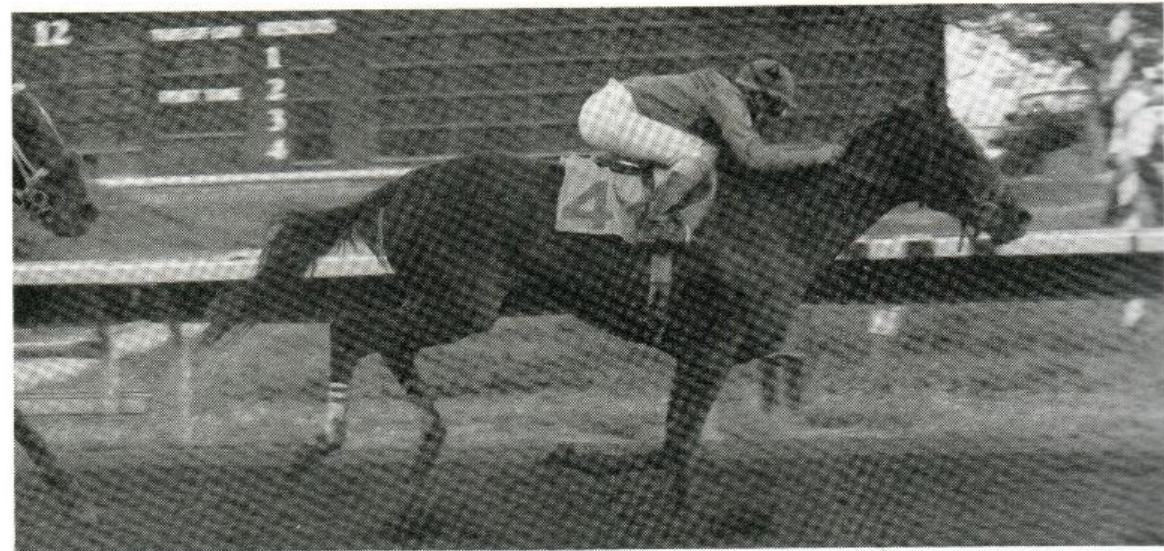

FAVORED IM CASADY POSTS WIN IN \$79,433 NEW MEXICO BREEDERS' QUARTER HORSE DERBY

Heavily favored, Im Casady did not disappoint his backers as he posted a half length win in the \$79,433 New Mexico Breeders' Quarter Horse Derby.

Sent off as the odds on choice, Im Casady broke on the lead for jockey Jerry Nicodemus and never looked back on his way to the win over runnerup Shazi. Jodis Feature was another half length back in third with Domestique fourth in the field of nine New Mexico bred 3 year olds.

The Sure Casady gelding was the fastest qualifier to the Breeders' Derby, posting a 20.20 second trial victory Sept. 14.

Trained by Don Farris, Im Casady covered the 400 yds. in the final in 20.11. Im Casady has now won three of four starts this year including a victory in the Santa Fe Derby in July.

The victory was worth \$39,716 to New Mexico breeder Fred Tidwell of Alamogordo.

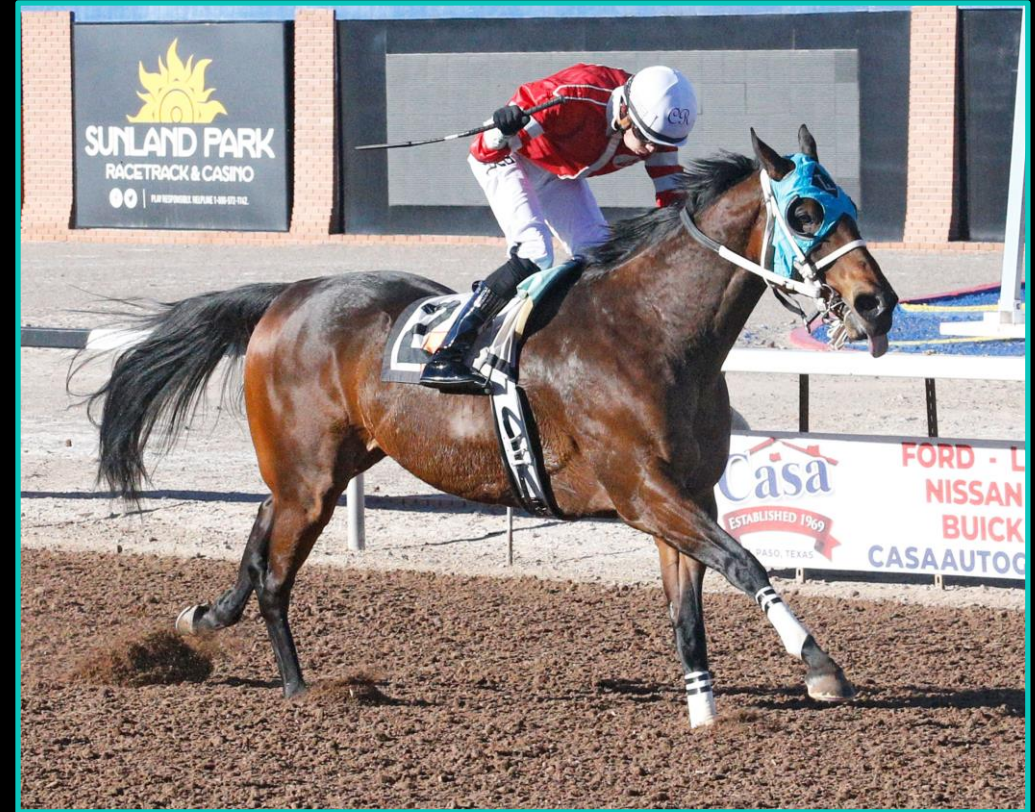

All foals **MUST BE** conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status. If a registered NM Broodmare in foal to a registered NM Stallion leaves the state of New Mexico:

- The application and the \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the breeding year. If the application and \$500 fee are NOT received by the applicable deadline, there is a ten day grace period and then the fee increases to \$1,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.
- Every donor mare and every recipient mare that is taken to board out of state must have their own form filled out and you must pay \$500.00 for each or the larger \$1,000 penalty if the October 1 deadline is missed.

EXCEPTION (Bylaw change January 25, 2024):

- **1. All assisted reproduction techniques including but not limited to the transfer of embryos or oocytes must be performed within the State of New Mexico unless the service is not readily available in the state. OOCYTES may be done in other states if the out-of-state ICSI requirements are followed. The mare would be required to be enrolled in the Export Broodmare Program by October 1st of the year she was taken out of New Mexico.**

EXPORT BROODMARE RETURN FORMS BEGINNING WITH 2022 FOALS ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED!

You must still fill out the Export Form and pay \$500 per mare by October 1!

STALLION EVA REQUIREMENTS
