“Registered New Mexico-bred Quarter Horses KJ Bad Moon Rising and Miss Hi Tide enjoyed success during Grade 1 stakes run at Albuquerque Downs on Labor Day weekend.

KJ Bad Moon Rising, a homebred son of the Apollitical Jess stallion KJ Mucho Macho Man racing for John Lee and Kathy Lee, ran second as the ninth-fastest overall qualifier in Quarter Horse racing’s richest race, the 440-yard, \$3-million All American Futurity (G1) for 2-year-olds. Trained by Wes Giles and ridden by Christian Ramos, the bay gelding finished a neck behind winner Hezgotthelook Z, who with his victory became the first winner of the sport’s Triple Crown in 43 years...

...**Miss Hi Tide** ran second as the ninth-fastest qualifier, a half of a length behind winner Especially Goodcandy, in the sport’s richest race for 3-year-old fillies, the 440-yard, \$661,653 All American Oaks (G1). Wes Giles trains the sorrel daughter of the Dash Ta Fame stallion Woodbridge for owner Uno Menos...”

Currently, the By-Laws, under Article IV – Meetings of Members, we are required to hold the annual meeting in January and the exact date and place of the meeting the following year is voted upon by the members present at the current annual meeting.

At one time, the Downs At Albuquerque ran their live meet in January and this worked well since a lot of our members were in Albuquerque and could come to the meeting. Now there is no racing going on in Albuquerque in January and this also falls during foaling and breeding season. The Trustees would like to be able to change this so that the meeting will be held at a better time of year and where more people would be available to attend. They would also prefer to hold the meeting in conjunction with the awards ceremony if possible.

Be sure to print your name clearly and sign your name. You must be a current member of the association and submit only one ballot. Ballots will be voided for anyone who does not print & sign their name, or submits more than one ballot.

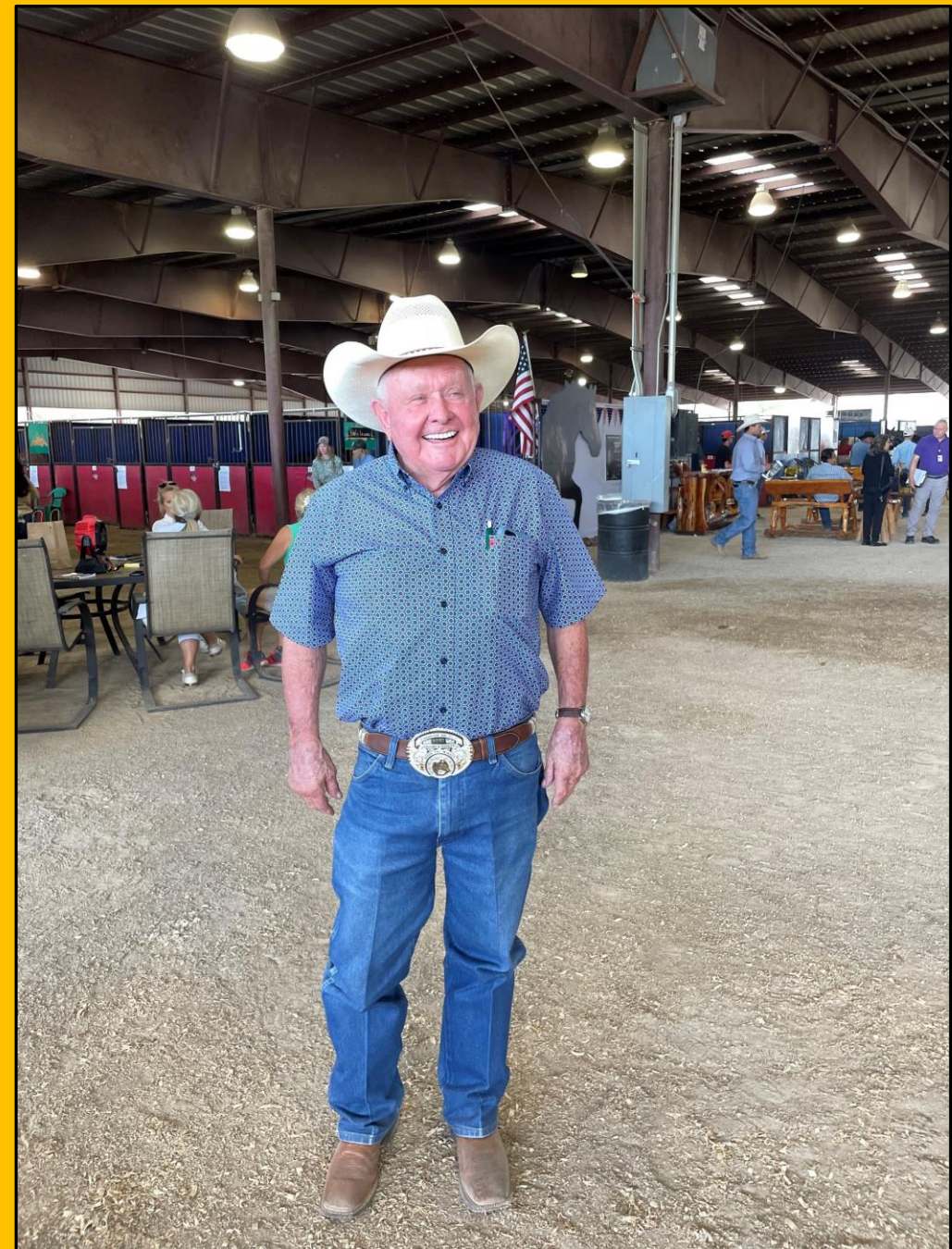

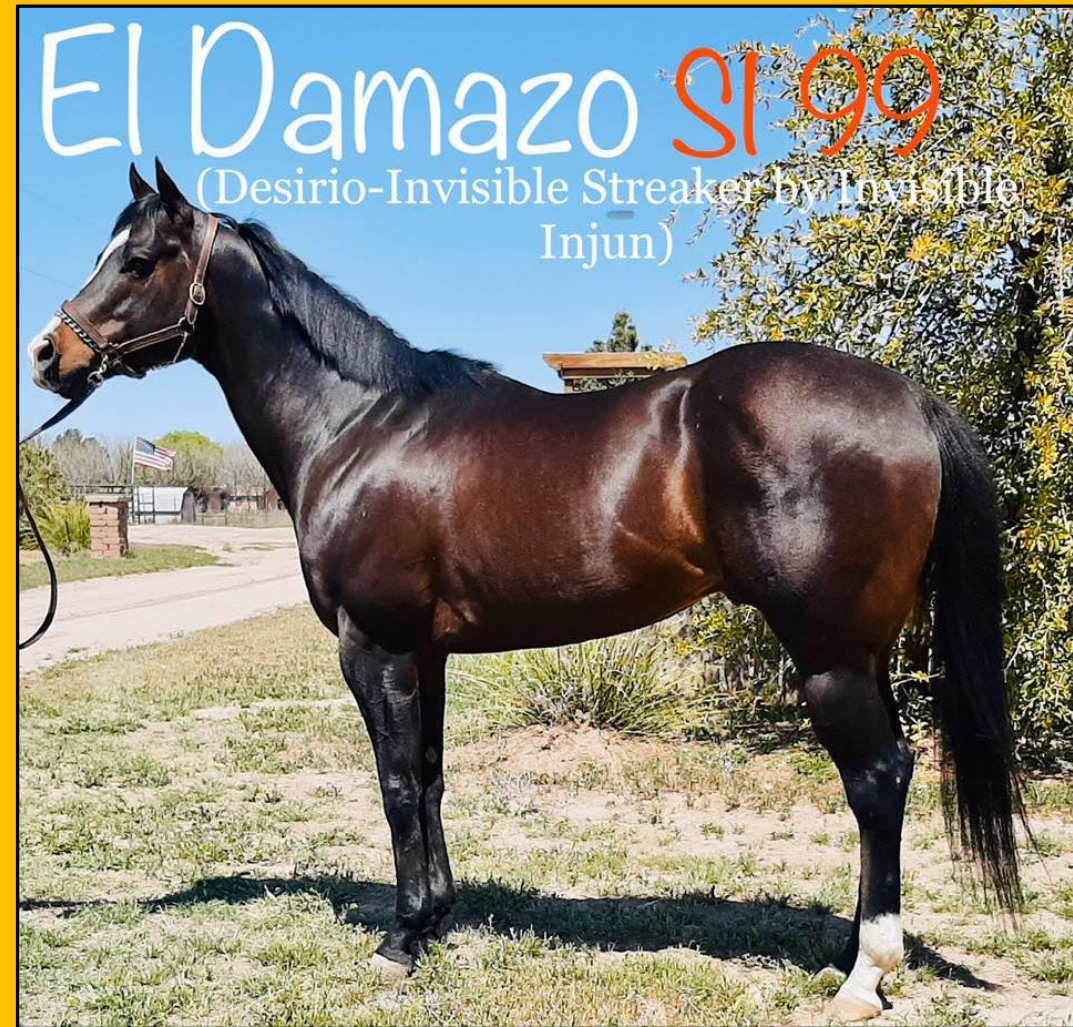

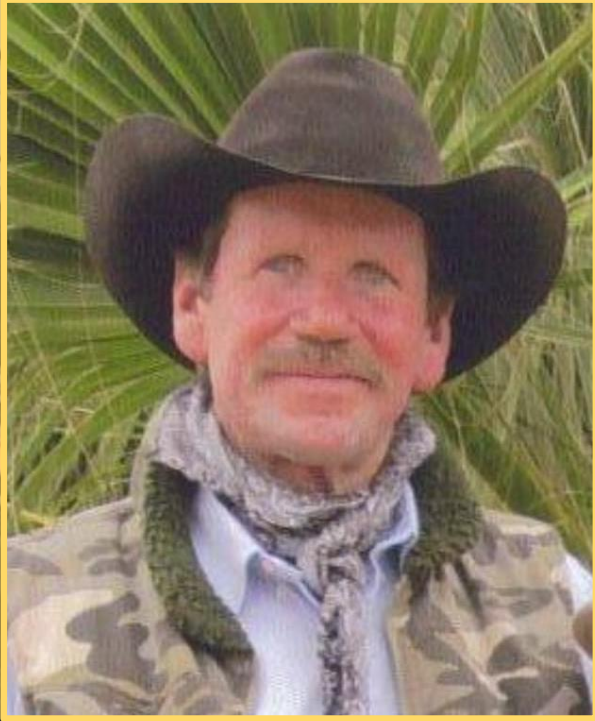

FIRST MOONFLASH



New Mexico Horse Breeder March 2010

It's not unusual for a New Mexico-bred Quarter Horse to win AQHA champion honors. In fact, three have done it in recent years, including 2008 champion distance horse High On Cat and '06 champion aged gelding Gotta Get.

But First Moonflash earned the 2009 title of champion aged stallion with a little extra flair. In addition to winning six stakes, including two open Grade 1s, during the season, the now 5-year-old stallion by the late First To Flash held world records at three different commonly-run distances – 350, 400, and 440 yards. He made history by becoming the first racehorse of any breed to hold world records at three different distances at the same time.

Bred by Dosi and Norma Alvarez of La Union, New Mexico, First Moonflash races for Pierre and Leslie Amestoy of Albuquerque and Maria G. Gonzalez of Edgewood, New Mexico. The Amestoy family also campaigned First To Flash, the winner of the 2002 Rainbow Futurity (G1) and that season's AQHA champion 2-year-old colt. They acquired First Moonflash for \$55,000 at the 2001 Ruidoso Select Yearling Sale.

"The fact that this horse was by First To Flash encouraged us to go to the sale to look at him," recalled Pierre Amestoy. "His conformation was exceptional. His knees were straight at you – they weren't at all offset – and he had a really good angle to his pastern and a really good foot."

The Alvarezes thought they'd bred a future champion

from the moment First Moonflash was foaled.

“He was drop-dead gorgeous,” said Norma Alvarez. “I’d never seen a more beautiful foal. He was one of those colts that you knew was special from the first time you saw him. He was just structurally perfect – he had good balance.

“He just had that look about him, and he was smart and easy to get along with,” she added. “We had no problem halter-breaking him.”

And First Moonflash had no problem getting down to business on the track, as the precocious colt won three of six races at age 2, including the \$106,115 New Mexico State Fair Senior Futurity (RG3) at The Downs at Albuquerque.

During his first season, his average winning margin of victory was nearly 2 ½ lengths. First Moonflash won a 400-yard Zia Futurity (RG1) trial by more than two lengths in just his second career out, but he caught one of those infamous Ruidoso Downs head winds and failed to qualify for the final.

First Moonflash also ended his 3-year-old season with a bang, setting the first of his world records when he won the 400-yard Championship at Sunland Park (G1) in :18.735. However, the beginning of his sophomore season was plagued with gate problems, as he kicked off the year with slow starts and seven consecutive losses.

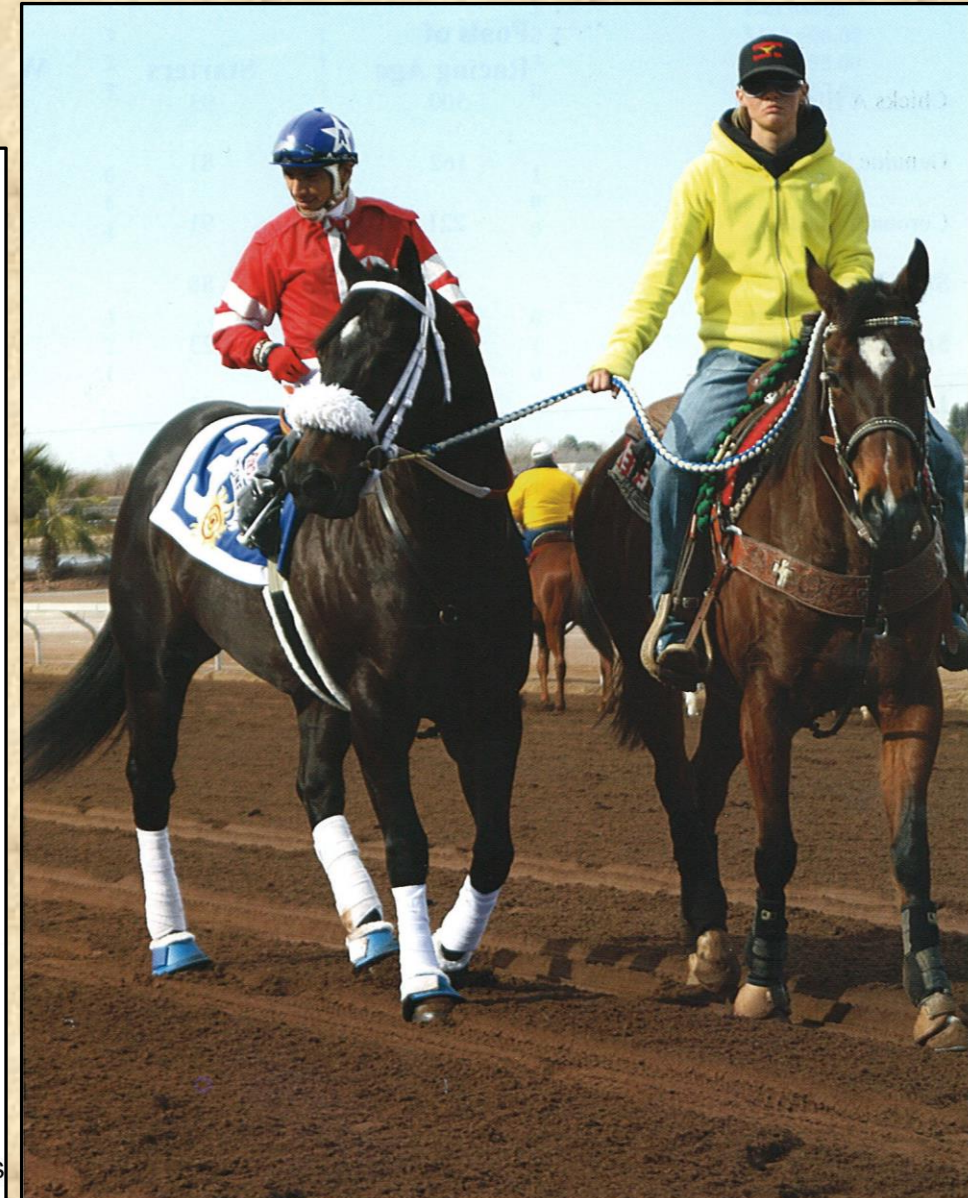
The Amestoyes made a trainer change, after which First Moonflash ran sixth in the All American Derby (G1). They

subsequently sold part interest in the colt to Maria Gonzalez and moved him to the barn of trainer Andres Gonzalez.

That’s when the consistently good performances began. First Moonflash ended his sophomore campaign with four straight wins. In addition to his record-breaking against open company in the Sunland Championship, he defeated state-breds in the \$218,018 New Mexico Cup Derby (RG1) and the \$125,000 Jess Burner Memorial Handicap (RG1).

“The Gonzalezes – Ramon and Andres – did a lot of work with him to get him to start breaking,” said Amestoy. “After the All American Derby, they took him back to the farm and started working with him and getting him comfortable in the gate. He’s only lost one race since then.”

That one loss was a fifth-place finish in last year’s 440-yard, \$200,000 Remington Park Invitational Championship (G1). The race, which offers its winner an automatic berth in the Champion of Champions (G1) at Los Alamitos, marked First Moonflash’s first and only start outside New Mexico and under the lights.

“Originally, we weren’t going to ship him to Remington for that race, but if he could have won that race, that would have given him a berth in the Champion of Champions,” said Amestoy.

“Then, we would have pointed him to the California races and taken him out there for the (Bank of America Challenge Championship), which he’d already qualified for at Sunland, and then the Champion of Champions.

“But two days after we got him home, he popped an abscess in his left

front foot,” he added. “After he broke that abscess, it took us a couple of months to get his foot right. That abscess changed our whole plan of going to California. That’s when we decided to just stay on the New Mexico circuit.”

The Remington Invitational was the only blemish on what was otherwise a perfect 4-year-old campaign. During the year, First Moonflash won eight of nine races and earned \$491,040. He capped off the season – and his racing career – with his second consecutive Championship at Sunland Park victory. His other world records were set when he won the 350-yard Mesilla Valley Speed Handicap (RG2) in :16.715, and the 440-yard Bank of America New Mexico Challenge (G1) in :20.274.

First Moonflash will stand the 2010 breeding season for a \$5,000 fee at W.L. Mooring’s Double L Farm at Bosque, New Mexico. His final record – 14 wins in 25 outs, including 10 stakes victories, and earnings of \$969,828.

With First Moonflash’s career earnings so close to the magic \$1-million mark, Amestoy admitted his owners were tempted to race him at least one more time.

“Yes, there was thought about that,” he said. “But every time you race a horse, there’s a chance something can go wrong. He could have gotten hurt, and his value as a stallion was so great. He’d won all those Grade 1 races and broken those world records. The million-dollar milestone was one we wanted to make, but the races just didn’t fall into place the right way.

“For the three years he raced, he did everything we ever asked of him. He is just a fantastic horse.”

All foals **MUST BE** conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status. If a registered NM Broodmare in foal to a registered NM Stallion leaves the state of New Mexico:

- The application and the \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the breeding year. If the application and \$500 fee are NOT received by the applicable deadline, there is a ten day grace period and then the fee increases to \$1,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.
- Every donor mare and every recipient mare that is taken to board out of state must have their own form filled out and you must pay \$500.00 for each or the larger \$1,000 penalty if the October 1 deadline is missed.

EXCEPTION (Bylaw change January 25, 2024):

- **1. All assisted reproduction techniques including but not limited to the transfer of embryos or oocytes must be performed within the State of New Mexico unless the service is not readily available in the state. OOCYTES may be done in other states if the out-of-state ICSI requirements are followed. The mare would be required to be enrolled in the Export Broodmare Program by October 1st of the year she was taken out of New Mexico.**

EXPORT BROODMARE RETURN FORMS BEGINNING WITH 2022 FOALS ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED!

You must still fill out the Export Form and pay \$500 per mare by October 1!

STALLION EVA REQUIREMENTS
