ALL 3 BY-LAW CHANGES PASSED

.BY-LAW PROPOSAL TO ALLOW MARES TO FOAL OUT OF STATE

ARTICLE II - DEFINITION

Article II - amended January 27, 2017 - the following sentences continue to apply to those mares residing in New Mexico: "The foal's dam must remain in New Mexico for the duration of pregnancy and foaling and may only leave the State temporarily for emergency veterinary care, or for other similar reasons expressly approved in writing by the Board of Trustees. During pregnancy, the dam's owner must give prior notice to the Association whenever the dam leaves the State and must state the reason for the absence except that prior notice shall not be required for emergency veterinary treatment."

NEW LANGUAGE: "The mare must be located in New Mexico at the time of foaling in the New Mexico Permanent Stallion Registry. Acceptance of a foal may take place outside of New Mexico for ICSE if not available in New Mexico. If a pregnant mare, or recipient mare goes out of state (other than for emergency veterinary care), as permission to leave New Mexico to participate in a sale, the mare owner must pay a \$1000 mare fee due by October 1st (this fee doubles if submitted after October 1st) and if a pregnant mare does not come back to New Mexico to foal, there is an additional fee of \$1000 due at time of registration."

The Association may require affidavits as it deems necessary to verify compliance with the above definition. Failure (by owner) to submit affidavits upon request of the Association shall result in the disqualification of such foal to be a New Mexico Bred horse.

*If approved by the members, this would go into effect with foals born in 2025.

BY-LAW PROPOSAL TO ALLOW TRUSTEES TO ATTEND MEETINGS BY ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS

ARTICLE V - BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Section 1 - General Powers

Section 2 - Regular Meetings of the Board of Trustees

A regular meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be held immediately after and in the same place as the annual meeting of members. The Board of Trustees may, by resolution, provide for the holding of additional regular meetings.

Section 3 - Special Meetings

Special meetings of the Trustees may be called by the request of the Executive Director or any four (4) Trustees. The person or persons calling such a meeting shall notify the Board of Trustees of the time and place for holding any special meeting of the Board of Trustees called by them.

Section 4 - Notice

Notice of any special meeting of the Trustees shall be given in the same manner as that required for meetings of members in ARTICLE IV, Section 4, herein.

NEW ADDITIONAL LANGUAGE: "Members of the Board of Trustees who cannot be present in person shall have the right to participate in regular and special meetings by means of a reliable electronic communications system provided by the association of which all persons participating in the meeting can hear and see each other at the same time and participation by such means shall constitute presence in person at a meeting."

BY-LAW PROPOSAL FOR TRUSTEE TERMS

ARTICLE V - BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Section 1 - General Powers


The business and affairs of the Association shall be managed by its Board of Trustees. The number of Trustees of the Association shall be twelve (12) *active horse breeders composed of six (6) thoroughbred breeders and six (6) quarter horse breeders. *Each Trustee shall hold office for a term of two (2) years. **NEW LANGUAGE: "A trustee term will expire after the second annual membership meeting that takes place after the year they are elected."**

A Trustee must be a voting member. The President of the Board of Trustees shall be retained as a non-voting member of the Board of Trustees for the succeeding year after his or her term as President has expired. The President of the Board of Trustees shall not be entitled to vote with the Board of Trustees except to break a tie vote. A nominee for Trustee must declare to the Board of Trustees whether he or she is an active horse breeder of thoroughbreds or an active horse breeder of quarter horses upon his or her nomination. A nominee for Trustee must have been a member in good standing during the twelve (12) months preceding his or her nomination. A Trustee must remain a member in good standing during his or her term as Trustee. Any Trustee who ceases to be a member or an active horse breeder in good standing shall be deemed to have resigned as Trustee. The terms of the Trustee shall be staggered, three (3) quarter horse and three (3) thoroughbred breeders being elected each year.

* An active horse breeder for the purpose of qualifying to be a NMHBA Trustee is defined as a person who registers Thoroughbred or Quarter Horse foals 1 out of the last 3 consecutive years.

WHAT IS BIOSECURITY?

Almost everyone in the horse racing world is aware of the EIA outbreak that is currently ongoing. The outbreak is at high enough levels that the whole horse industry has started to take notice. The origin of the current outbreak has not been released but the method of transmission has been confirmed to be iatrogenic (induced unintentionally by medical treatment or procedure). In addition to EIA, EHV -1 keeps appearing. Breeders are worried (justifiably) and starting to wonder what they can do and what strategies can be implemented to reduce risk. You will hear veterinarians use the term biosecurity. So exactly What is biosecurity? Biosecurity is the practice of preventing the spread of disease-causing agents that can harm people, animals, crops and the environment. These are diseases that will cause an economic impact to your business. If you do not have in place a biosecurity program, please consider the following information if you to decide its time to implement one. If you already have a biosecurity program in place it may be time to review it..." – Leah Starr, DVM

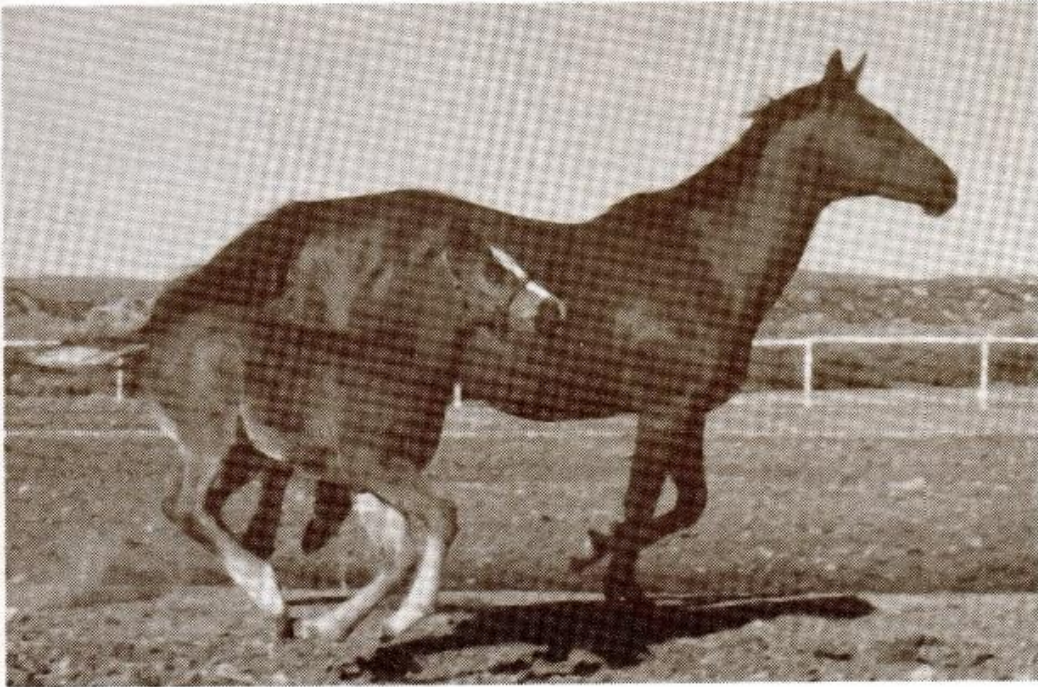

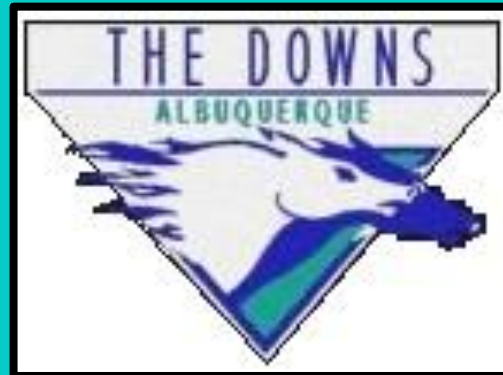

You don't have to wait for your AQHA or Jockey Club papers to submit a New Mexico Bred application for your foals!
All foals **MUST BE** conceived in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status.

Remember the horse is NOT an official New Mexico Bred & CANNOT run in a NM Bred race until the certificates have been finalized by our office.

AQHA papers must be stamped in our office.
Jockey Club papers are "stamped" online.

EXPORT BROODMARE FORMS

NEW RULES COMING SOON REGARDING ICSI, EXPORT BROODMARE PROGRAM AND OUT OF STATE FOALING.



All foals **MUST BE** conceived in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status.

If a Broodmare (Dam, Donor Mare (open or carrying) and/or Recipient Mares) bred to a registered NM Stallion, spends any part of the pregnancy outside the state of New Mexico:

- The application and the \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the breeding year. If the application and \$500 fee are NOT received by the applicable deadline, there is a ten day grace period and then the fee increases to \$1,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.
- Every donor mare and every recipient mare that is taken to board out of state must have their own form filled out and you must pay \$500.00 for each or the larger \$1,000 penalty if the October 1 deadline is missed.

EXCEPTION (Bylaw change January 25, 2024):

- 1. All assisted reproduction techniques including but not limited to the transfer of embryos or oocytes must be performed within the State of New Mexico unless the service is not readily available in the state. OOCYTES may be done in other states if the out-of-state ICSI requirements are followed. The mare would be required to be enrolled in the Export Broodmare Program by October 1st of the year she was taken out of New Mexico.

Bylaw change January 28, 2025: "The mare must be bred in New Mexico to an active stallion in the New Mexico Permanent Stallion Registry. Exception: the breeding may take place outside of New Mexico for ICSI if not available in New Mexico. If a pregnant mare, donor mare, or recipient mare goes out of state (other than for emergency veterinary care or has permission to leave New Mexico to participate in a sale) there is a \$500 Export Broodmare fee due by October 1st (this fee doubles if submitted after October 10th) and if a pregnant mare does not come back to New Mexico to foal, there is an additional fee of \$500 due at time of registration."

All mares must be registered in the Permanent New Mexico Broodmare Registry by September 1 of the breeding year or penalties will apply to all foals.

STALLION EVA REQUIREMENTS

EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW STALLIONS

All stallions MUST have a negative EVA test and be vaccinated for EVA within 10 days of the COLLECTION date according to the rules of the New Mexico Livestock Board before you can register them in the NM Permanent Stallion Registry.

EVA REQUIREMENTS FOR STALLIONS IN OUR REGISTRY

All NM registered stallions must have an annual EVA booster vaccination.

Per NM Livestock Board regulations, they must be quarantined for 28 days after receiving the booster because it is a live virus and can be passed to other horses.

The deadline to turn in the EVA Booster Certificate to our office is February 1, 2025.

HORSE RESCUE IN NEW MEXICO



The State of New Mexico, in cooperation with members of the State Legislature and Governor's Office, established laws governing horse rescues in the State of New Mexico.

The New Mexico Livestock Board is the regulatory authority governing abuse and neglect of Livestock.

In conjunction with the livestock industry, horse industry veterinarians and humane associations, a procedure for the care of abandoned and neglected horses has been established and implemented in New Mexico.

The New Mexico Livestock Board licenses horse rescue, sanctuary and retirement facilities in the state. This includes facilities which provide care for captured wild horses that cannot be returned to their range. Listed below are the facilities currently licensed and approved . These licensed facilities have subscribed to the standards of care for horses as detailed in "**Care Guidelines for Equine Rescue and Retirement Facilities**", published by the American Association of Equine Practitioners.
