UPDATED RULES FOR ICSI/EXPORT BROODMARE PROGRAM

The following are updated Rules that were voted on by the
NMHBA Board of Trustees on March 12, 2025:

Export Broodmare Program:

- ALL broodmares must have spent a minimum of 30 consecutive days in New Mexico the year the breeding took place AND the year of pregnancy or the resulting foals(s) are ineligible to be registered as New Mexico Breds.

ICSI Export Broodmare Program:

- \$500 Donor Mare ICSI Export Broodmare Fee due by October 1 of the year of ICSI procedure AND each year of pregnancy (whenever she left the state of New Mexico).
- The Donor Mare must have spent a minimum of 30 consecutive days in New Mexico the year the ICSI procedure took place AND the year each pregnancy is confirmed.
- If for any reason any of the requirements of these rules cannot be adhered to, a request for a variance must be submitted to the New Mexico Horse Breeders Board of Trustees in order to be considered for New Mexico Bred registration.



Trained by Jesus Soto and racing against a reported 5-mph head wind, Harken covered 400 yards in :19.457, and his margin of victory was a half of a length from fastest qualifier Daou. Sergio Becerra Jr. rode the gelding.

Harken was coming off of a wire-to-wire, one-length win in the first of five West Texas Derby trials on February 8. The gelding was bred in New Mexico by Mac and Janis Murray’s MJ Farms, and he was a \$145,000 yearling buy at the 2023 New Mexico-Bred Sale at Ruidoso Downs...”

In addition to EIA, EHV-1 keeps appearing. Breeders are worried (justifiably) and starting to wonder what they can do and what strategies can be implemented to reduce risk. You will hear veterinarians use the term biosecurity. So exactly What is biosecurity? Biosecurity is the practice of preventing the spread of disease-causing agents that can harm people, animals, crops and the environment. These are diseases that will cause an economic impact to your business. If you do not have in place a biosecurity program, please consider the following information if you to decide its time to implement one. CHALLENGER SIX WINS JUAREZ HANDICAP AT 3-1 ODDS

Challenger Six, Sunland Park's newest track record holder, took an impressive in the \$10,250 Juarez Handicap on Saturday.

The fast five-year-old son of Six Fortunes was let go by the betting public at 3-1 odds. He raced wide for much of the 870 yard race but accelerated well under the controls of jockey Jerry Rodriguez.

Challenger Six pulled clear in upper stretch and was hand ridden to a 1 1/2 length victory. The victory was

the sixth in his last seven starts and was worth \$6,150 to the Rocking R Enterprises of Houston, Texas. He increased his lifetime earning to over \$65,000.

Despite breaking from the #7 post position, Challenger Six sped through the distance in a quick 45.02 seconds.

The track record holder for 870 yards paid \$8.00 on a \$2 win ticket.

Power Stretch, the runner-up in the Mr. Vale Handicap, made a late bid to gain second for trainer Ramon Gonzalez. The race was his first since Oct. 15.

Always Short Enough, a 60-1 longshot, completed a \$2 trifecta that was worth \$1,421.80.





Export Broodmare Form Rules & Instructions

All foals **MUST BE** conceived and born in NM to be eligible for NM Bred status. If a Broodmare (Dam, Donor Mare (open or carrying) and/or Recipient Mares) bred to a registered NM Stallion, spends any part of the pregnancy outside the state of New Mexico:

- The application and the \$500 fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the breeding year. If the application and \$500 fee are NOT received by the applicable deadline, there is a ten day grace period and then the fee increases to \$1,000 for the foal to be eligible for NM Bred status.
- All mares bred in New Mexico **MUST RESIDE IN NEW MEXICO A MINIMUM OF 30 CONSECUTIVE DAYS** the year the breeding took place AND the year of pregnancy before leaving the state of New Mexico or the resulting foals(s) are ineligible to be registered as New Mexico Breds.
- Every donor mare and every recipient mare that is taken to board out of state must have their own form filled out and you must pay \$500.00 for each or the larger \$1,000 penalty if the October 1 deadline is missed.

EXCEPTION (Bylaw change January 25, 2024):

- 1. All assisted reproduction techniques including but not limited to the transfer of embryos or oocytes must be performed within the State of New Mexico unless the service is not readily available in the state. OOCYTES may be done in other states if the out-of-state ICSI requirements are followed. The mare would be required to be enrolled in the Export Broodmare Program by October 1st of the year she was taken out of New Mexico.

All mares must be registered in the Permanent New Mexico Broodmare Registry by September 1 of the breeding year or penalties will apply to all foals.

ICSI PROGRAM

The by-law change voted on at the 2025 Annual Meeting now allows mares to foal outside of the state of New Mexico. This will require paying the Export Broodmare Fee AND the Out Of State Foaling Fee.

STARTING FEBRUARY 15, 2025:

The Donor Mare must have spent a minimum of 30 consecutive days in New Mexico the year the ICSI procedure took place AND the year each pregnancy is confirmed.

All mares MUST BE ASPIRATED IN NEW MEXICO for ICSI or the resulting foals(s) are ineligible to be registered as New Mexico Breds.

If for any reason any of the requirements of these rules cannot be adhered to, a request for a variance must be submitted to the New Mexico Horse Breeders Board of Trustees in order to be considered for New Mexico Bred registration.

EXCEPTION (Bylaw change January 25, 2024):

- 1. All assisted reproduction techniques including but not limited to the transfer of embryos or oocytes must be performed within the State of New Mexico unless the service is not readily available in the state. OOCYTES may be done in other states if the out-of-state ICSI requirements are followed. Per NM Livestock Board regulations, they must be quarantined for 28 days after receiving the booster because it is a live virus and can be passed to other horses.



The State of New Mexico, in cooperation with members of the State Legislature and Governor's Office, established laws governing horse rescues in the State of New Mexico.


The New Mexico Livestock Board is the regulatory authority governing abuse and neglect of Livestock.

In conjunction with the livestock industry, horse industry veterinarians and humane associations, a procedure for the care of abandoned and neglected horses has been established and implemented in New Mexico.

The New Mexico Livestock Board licenses horse rescue, sanctuary and retirement facilities in the state. This includes facilities which provide care for captured wild horses that cannot be returned to their range. Listed below are the facilities currently licensed and approved . These licensed facilities have subscribed to the standards of care for horses as detailed in "**Care Guidelines for Equine Rescue and Retirement Facilities**", published by the American Association of Equine Practitioners.
