



ICSI EXPORT BROODMARE FORM RULES & INSTRUCTIONS

This form is for Donor Mares that spent any time outside the state of New Mexico during the ICSI procedure and/or pregnancy, and for Recipient Mares that spent any time outside the state of New Mexico during their pregnancy.

The Donor Mare must have spent a minimum of 30 consecutive days in New Mexico the year the ICSI procedure took place AND the year each pregnancy is confirmed, or this application will be voided and money refunded. The Recipient Mare does NOT have to be in NM for any amount of time.

The Donor Mare must be aspirated in New Mexico and OOCYTES must be sent to a qualifying lab to be inseminated with **qualifying semen from a New Mexico Accredited Stallion**.

Definition of Qualifying Semen from a New Mexico Accredited Stallion:

As long as the semen was collected and frozen in New Mexico and shipped to an ICSI Laboratory only, it can be stored and used indefinitely as long as the stallion remains active in the New Mexico Horse Breeders Stallion Registry.

BOTH the Donor Mare and all Recipient Mares MUST be registered with the NMHBA in the NMHBA Permanent Broodmare Registry no later than September 1st of the breeding year for the Donor Mare and September 1st of the year of pregnancy for the Recipient Mare or penalties will apply.

Donor Mare Export Broodmare Fee – due by October 1, of either the year of ICSI procedure or year of pregnancy

- This application and the \$500 ICSI Export Broodmare fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the year the Donor leaves the state for the ICSI procedure **AND** each year of pregnancy (whenever she left the state of New Mexico). If this fee is not received by October 10, the fee (and penalty) due is \$1,000.
- If the Donor Mare stays in the state of New Mexico the year of the ICSI procedure but leaves the state of New Mexico the year of pregnancy, this application and the \$500 ICSI Export Broodmare fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the year of the pregnancy. If this fee is not received by October 10, the fee (and penalty) due is \$1,000.
- If ICSI will be performed on the Donor Mare in another state after being aspirated in New Mexico after October 1st, you will have 10 days from the date the Donor Mare leaves the state, to submit the form and pay the \$500 Export Broodmare fee. If this fee is not received within 10 days of the Donor Mare leaving the state of New Mexico, the fee (and penalty) due is \$1,000.

Recipient Mare Export Broodmare Fee– due by October 1, the year of pregnancy

- This application and the \$500 ICSI Export fee must be postmarked no later than the deadline of October 1st of the year the Recipient Mare is pregnant outside the State of New Mexico. If this fee is not received by October 10, the fee (and penalty) due is \$1,000.
- If the Recipient Mare leaves the state of New Mexico after October 1st, you will have 10 days from the date the Recipient Mare leaves the state, to submit the form and pay the \$500 Export Broodmare fee. If this fee is not received within 10 days of the Recipient Mare leaving the state of New Mexico, the fee (and penalty) due is \$1,000.

If for any reason any of the requirements of these rules cannot be adhered to, a request for a variance must be submitted to the New Mexico Horse Breeders Board of Trustees in order to be considered for New Mexico Bred registration.
